I will find the "exact" area where you could find the body and the murder weapon. You said you want the name of a person who knew something about the crime "when it happen". Vaughnetta is who you need. Tell her that Otis is about to get out "on a pardon" and she will talk, because she know's that if he gets out, he will kill her for what she did to him. Furthermore, you don't need to travel to F.S.P at State expense anymore. I will mail the information to you and if I need any special assistance I will request it by mail and you could call the prison investigator so that he may provide the assistance. One more thing before I close this letter. All other's unknown murders of

Toole and Lucas in the State of Florida; I will reveal them only for my freedom and new I.d. Remember that I'm not getting anything out of this Adam Walsh case except the label of a "Snitch" which is the lowest thing in life. Oh well, maybe I'll get a thank you card from the Walsh family when its over

I am 72 years old and if Ottis Toole isn't stopped from getting letters to me I won't live for my next birthday.

He knows thazt I know Becky Powell is dead and was murdered by Henry Lucas (I spoke with Becky Powell) both Lucas and Toole lived in the same house as I still do.

When she was alive.

This is a poor attempt at terrorism on Toole;s part. Becky was only 16 years old when she left for Texas with Lucas, when she told him she was going to leave him and go back to Florida to live with her grandmother, he killed her and dismembered her body. She waas a beautiful girl.

Please warn all prisoners not to write to me for Ottis Toole, as this should not have happened and especially not at Christmas time.

When Ottis lived where I live, I awake one morning hearing noises....he was trying to remove the hinges from my door....I opened the door and he was across the hall in the bathroom washing his hands. I said Ottis my door is nearly off, someone tried to break in, He said, "They did not" and stalked out.

So he tried to kill me...now he's trying to do it *NOW*

Sara was her half sister and Frank her Brother.

Arzetta died in 1981 of a drug overdose. She was buried at the cemetery in Arundale Florida.

Becky Powell is ~~is~~ 27 years of age now and will be 28 this February.

Her real name is Frieda Lorene Powell.

Anyways she wants you to write her at P.O. Box 95, Cape Girardeau MO 63701.

Also Otis wants you to come visit him.

I truly hope you will believe me.

And I truly do hope you will write her.

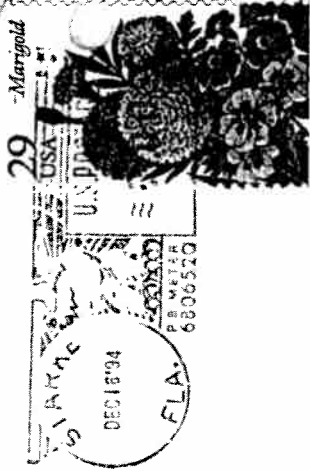
