 sworn deposes and says that on the 28 day of Jan. 19 80 at 851 SW 3 Ave Pompano Beach  
101 SW 17 St Pompano Beach  
 CRIME LOCATION

the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe same are as follows:

On Monday, 1-28-80, at app. 1545hrs, Det. Bill responded to the area of Cypress Elem. School reference a white van which may be involved in a sex offense. Det. Bill observed a white male sitting in a white van parked on the South side of the school. Det. Bill approached the van with I.D. and Police badge out and upon identifying myself as a Police Officer the subject proceeded to drive away. He was chased for app. 4 block by Det. Bill and Ofc. O'Brien in unmarked vehicles, but with the blue lights on and the horns blasting. Det. Bill finally pulled his veh. in front of the van forcing it to a stop in the 100 block of Lyons Park Dr. The subject was removed from the van at which time a knife was observed in a open case taped to the steering column. Ofc. O'Brien advised the defendant of his rights witness by Det. Bill.

On Sat. 1-19-80, at app. 1800hrs, at 101 SW 17 St. Pompano Beach, a white male masturbated in front of three boys who he had inside his van. The juveniles positively identified the defendant from a photo line up this date. They also positively identified the van.

On Sat. 1-26-80, at 1630hrs, at 851 SW 3 Ave. Pompano Beach, a white male matching the description masturbated in front of two juveniles from inside a white van. The victims positively identified the defenanadt from a photo line up this date. All the victims involved in the sex offense were under the age of fourteen.

- Q. For the record Detectives Sonntag and Bill are Notary Publics in and for the State of Florida at large. Mr. Davenport would you raise your right hand. Do you solemnly that the statement that you are about to give will be the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth so help you God?
- A. I do.
- Q. Alright sir at this time you understand that you are being charged with indecent or lewd act in the presence of a child under the age of 14. You are being charged with two separate counts under law by our Police Department. Is that correct?
- A. Yes.
- Q. The incident that we are going to discuss is an incident that occurred at...or in the area of the Cypress Elementary School located at 841 SW 3 Ave, City of Pompano Beach. Are you familiar with the area where Cypress Plaza is?
- A. Yes.
- Q. And where Cypress Elementary School is?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Before we discuss this incident Mr. Davenport were you advised of your constitutional rights by Detective Bill at approximately 7:00 PM?
- A. Yes.
- Q. And we've discussed these incidents verbally or prior to getting on a statement is that correct?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Have we made you give us a statement or have we made you or forced you in any way to talk with us about these incidents?
- A. No.
- Q. Do you understand your constitutional rights fully?
- A. Yes.
- Q. OK before, this is what we call a Rights Form with the name Gary Leon Davenport on the bottom, is that your signature sir?
- A. Yes.
- Q. You understands each of the rights as read to you by Detective Bill?
- A. Yes.

- Q. Mr. Davenport on the date January 26, 1980, at approximately 4:30 in the afternoon, did you have occasion to be in the area of Cypress Elementary School here in the City of Pompano?
- A. Yes.
- Q. And at that time were you driving your Van?
- A. Yes.
- Q. What kind of Van is it again please?
- A. 1974 Ford Econoline.
- Q. Is it white in color?
- A. Yes.
- Q. It has two black lights mounted kind of like on the roof in the back?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Is there a motorcycle inside your van?
- A. Yes.
- Q. What other property do you have inside your van?
- A. All my personal belongings, clothing, home made bed, food.
- Q. At this time you do not really maintain a residence anywhere is that correct?
- A. Thats correct.
- Q. And you've been kind of like vacationing down here in Florida and living out of your van?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Back to the date and time in question in the area of Cypress Elementary Did you have occasion to see two young boys playing the area of some rocks and stuff around the school?
- A. Yes.
- Q. And would you describe what actions you took in relation to these two kids, what happened over there by the school?
- A. I parked my Van on the opposite side of the street where they were playing and
- Q. Do you recall if you said anything to the kids?
- A. I never said a word to them.
- Q. Then what did you do?
- A. I just opened up the driver door, had my shorts, my cut off jeans or whatever you want to call them, had them down around by the ankles, but I just sat there and played with myself, knowing the kids were watching me. After I climaxed I just drove off.
- Q. Approximately how long did you stay in that position, do you.....
- A. I don't really know, five minutes or so.
- Q. If people would come by, like drive by or in that area, would you close the door, do you remember ever closing the door when people came by.
- A. Yes. There was one car that came by and I closed the door.
- Q. OK and then after a car would be gone or whatever you opened the door' back up and exposed your penis to these children?

A. Yes.

Q. You never touched these children in any way?

A. Never touched them, never said a word to them.

Q. You were aware however they were watching you and seeing what you were doing?

A. Yes.

Q. I know we discussed this in another statement uh... at the time that you were doing this, did you realize you were doing something that was wrong, immoral and actually against the law?

A. Yes.

Q. You stated prior that you've had this problem for approximately 20 years that you're aware of?

A. Yes

Q. Again, in this statement do you feel that there is a way that you can be helped to rid yourself of this problem or quit doing this?

A. I can only hope that through physiological examination and all this that somebody can help me.

Q. Is there anything further you want to add in this statement? Again this is separate from the other one and may be read separately by somebody else, and anything you wish to say that you feel could be pertinent to this case or.....

A. Well only that I feel bad for what I've done. I have strong guilt feelings, but it still doesn't prevent me from doing it.

Q. Is there any doubt in your mind that if you wouldn't have been apprehended or caught by the police department that you would continue doing this?

A. No doubt whatsoever.

Q. We've discussed other cases same of that nature. Is there any occasion... I understand that you told us in this statement that you didn't touch these children or um... even talk to them in this case. But have you ever hurt anyone as far as this problem is concerned?

A. Physically no, I don't know what harm psychologically that it may cause some of these kids.

Q. And you feel bad when you are doing this?

A. Yes. I only hope that the kids don't become effected by it the way I have. This is... this is the same thing that has happened to me when I was a kid and I think that's part of my problem.

Q. Is that part of your guilt feeling that this happened to you when you were a kid and may have caused what happened now and you think that maybe you are doing it to these kids. Is that part of the guilt or what ever you want to call it.

A. Yeah. I know what happened to me at the time it was a big joke but I feel that it has something to do with the problem that I've got now.

Q. OK Mr. Davenport is there anything further that you want to add to this statement.

A. I can't think of anything else.

Q. Today when the Officer came up to you I understand that you were in the same park or the same area as when this thing that we were talking about had occurred. Is that correct?

A. I was on the other side of the school but....

Q. Same type, same area, general.

A. Yeah.

Q. When the Officer pulled up he was in a plain..unmarked<sup>car</sup> and tried to show you the badge or did show you his badge and to talk to you and try to get you to stop and you took off from that area what was the reasons that you left that area?

A. When he pulled in he pulled in kind of fast around the front of my van. At the time I didn't know he was a Policeman, didn't see a badge. I didn't hear him say that he was a Policeman.

Q. Did you hear him yelling to stop and things like that?

A. What I heard was....I think I heard him saying Hay mister just as I was pulling away from the curb and put it bluntly, getting out of the area.

Q. Why were you in such a hurry to get out of there when he pulled in?

A. I thought he was probably a parent of one of the kids.

Q. Is there any reason that you couldn't hear him call?

A. I had the radio on in the van.

Q. So even though he was showing identification or trying to you were more in a hurry to get out of there and were not paying a whole lot of attention I assume?

A. Right. I deliberately avoided looking at him because I figure if I don't look at him he isn't going to get a good look at me. And I'll just leave.

Q. And subsequent to that he pulled over in front of you and you saw the lights in the car and stuff like that. Is that correct?

A. As I...I don't know where it was where I got pulled over or where I pulled off the road. As I started to turn, make a left hand turn I could hear him tooting the horn in back and that's when I looked behind me and I saw the blue light on the dash. And I pulled over.

THIS IS A SUPPLEMENT TO OFFENSE REPORT CASE NUMBER 002903 AND 0020 ADD STATUS OF PERSON ARREST- DAVENPORT, GARY LEON, CHARGES-OBSTRUCT OFFICER IN THE LAWFUL EXECUTION OF DUTY, FSS 843.02 (4 COUNTS), LEWD, LASCIVIOUS, OR INDECENT ACT IN PRESENCE OF CHILD, SECOND DEGREE FELONY, FSS 800.04.

ON MONDAY, 1/28/80, OFFICER O'BRIEN AND DETECTIVE BILL RESPONDED TO CYPRESS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, 851 SW 3 AVENUE, POMPANO BEACH, BROWARD COUNTY, FLA, IN REFERENCE TO A SEX OFFENSE SUSPECT. OFFICERS HAD RECEIVED INFORMATION FROM VICTIMS OF PREVIOUS SEX OFFENSES THAT AN UNKNOWN SUSPECT HAD EXPOSED HIMSELF AND MASTURBATED IN FRONT OF APPROXIMATELY 4 OR MORE VICTIMS, ALL BEING WHITE MALES BETWEEN THE AGES OF 5 TO 10 YEARS OLD ( THERE ARE POSSIBLY ADDITIONAL VICTIMS TO THESE OFFENSES) AND OFFICERS HAD BEEN DISPATCHED TO THE AREA IN REFERENCE TO A POSSIBLE SUSPECT BEING AT THAT LOCATION.

DETECTIVES ASSIGNED TO THE CASE BROADCAST BOLOS ON THE SUSPECT AND VEHICLE INVOLVED AND THE BOLOS GAVE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIPTION: SUSPECT, WM, APPROXIMATELY 30-40 YEARS OF AGE, MEDIUM LENGTH BROWN HAIR, CLEAN SHAVEN, SLENDER BUILD, TAN COMPLEXION.

VEHICLE- WHITE VAN, NO WINDOWS, SIDE DOOR, WHITE ROOF VENT, WITH A MOTOR CYCLE ATTACHED TO THE REAR OF THE VAN.

UPON ARRIVAL AT 1547 HOURS OFFICER O'BRIEN AND DETECTIVE BILL BEGAN TO CHECK THE AREA OF THE SCHOOL. DETECTIVE BILL OBSERVED A WHITE COLORED 1975 FORD VAN BEARING ARIZONA 1980 TAG 2KJ-303, PARKED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SCHOOL, FACING WEST, AND SAME VEHICLE WAS OBSERVED TO BE OCCUPIED BY A WHITE MALE, APPROXIMATELY 30-40 YEARS OF AGE. DETECTIVE BILL ALSO OBSERVED A MOTOR-CYCLE IN THE REAR SECTION OF SAME VAN. AT THIS TIME DETECTIVE BILL APPROACHED VEHICLE ON FOOT, GOT THE ATTENTION OF THE WHITE MALE OCCUPANTS/DRIVER, AND IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS A POLICE OFFICER, DISPLAYING HIS POLICE BADGE AND IDENTIFICATION CARD. AT THIS TIME THE OCCUPANT/DRIVER STARTED SAME VEHICLE AND BEGAN TO DRIVE AWAY FROM THE SCENE, FAILING TO STOP AS ORDERED BY DETECTIVE BILL. AT THIS TIME THE OCCUPANT/DRIVER PROCEEDED EAST BOUND ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SCHOOL. OFFICER O'BRIEN, WHO WAS ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SCHOOL, ALSO OBSERVED THE DEFENDANT (DAVENPORT) DRIVING AWAY FROM THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED AND BOTH DETECTIVE BILL AND OFFICER O'BRIEN CHASED THE DEFENDANT ATTEMPTING TO HAVE THE DEFENDANT PULL HIS VEHICLE TO THE SIDE OF THE ROAD. BOTH OFFICERS UTILIZED THE BLUE LIGHTS ON THEIR POLICE UNITS, HOWEVER THE DEFENDANT REFUSED TO STOP HIS VEHICLE. DETECTIVE BILL THEN PASSED THE DEFENDANT'S VEHICLE, PULLED IN FRONT OF THE DEFENDANT'S VEHICLE, COMING TO A GRADUAL STOP, THUS FORCING THE DEFENDANT AND VEHICLE TO STOP. BOTH OFFICERS APPROACHED THE DEFENDANT AND VEHICLE AND AGAIN IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES.

AT THIS TIME THE DEFENDANT (DAVENPORT) WAS REQUESTED TO EXIT HIS VEHICLE, WHICH HE DID, AND HE WAS IMMEDIATELY PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR OBSTRUCTING AN OFFICER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES. THE DEFENDANT (DAVENPORT) WAS IMMEDIATELY ADVISED OF HIS RIGHTS, WHICH HE ACKNOWLEDGED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD, BY OFFICER O'BRIEN.

AT THIS TIME OFFICERS OBSERVED THAT THE INTERIOR OF THE DEFENDANT'S

WHO STATED THE VEHICLE HAD A RED COLORED CARPET INSIDE. THE VEHICLE IN QUESTION ALSO HAD A MOTORCYCLE IN THE REAR SECTION. AT THIS TIME OFFICERS FELT THAT THIS WAS IN FACT THE SAME SUSPECT INVOLVED IN THE SEX OFFENSES, HOWEVER HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE BOOKED FOR THE OBSTRUCTION CHARGE, AND SO THAT A MORE COMPLETE INVESTIGATION COULD BE MADE CONCERNING THE SEX OFFENSES.

SOME OF THE VICTIMS OF THE SEX OFFENSES RESPONDED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED THE DEFENDANT (DAVENPORT) IN A PHOTO LINE UP. THE VEHICLE DRIVEN BY THE DEFENDANT WAS ALSO POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED BY THE VICTIMS. THE DEFENDANT WAS SUBSEQUENTLY CHARGED WITH 4 COUNTS OF LEWD AND LUSCIVIOUS, OR INDECENT ACTS IN PRESENCE OF CHILD, ALL SECOND DEGREE FELONIES, FSS 800.04.

WHILE INVENTORING THE DEFENDANT, OFFICERS LOCATED MISCELLANEOUS CLOTHING, FOOD, JEWELRY, AND MONEY. THE INTERIOR OF THE VEHICLE WAS INCOMPLETE DISARRAY AND WHILE INVENTORING SAME VEHICLE, OFFICERS LOCATED 52 ROLLS OF QUARTERS, 2 ROLLS OF NICKELS, 5 QUARTERS, 2 DIMES, ONE NICKEL, SEVEN PENNIES, 11 20 DOLLAR BILLS, AND 4 FIVE DOLLAR BILLS, IN A YELLOW COLORED SUITCASE. TOTAL VALUE \$765.57. OFFICERS ALSO LOCATED A CLEAR PLASTIC BAG CONTAINING MISCELLANEOUS JEWELRY IN A BLUE SUITCASE. THE JEWELRY CONSISTED OF: 4 GOLD WATCHES, TWO GOLD CHAINS (ONE BROKEN), 13 SETS OF CUFFLINKS, ONE SINGLE CUFFLINK, 4 TIE CLIPS, 5 TIE PINS, 1 RING, 1 MONEY CLIP, 1 ARIES COIN, 1 CIGARETTE LIGHTER. ALSO LOCATED IN THE VEHICLE WAS ONE BUCK TYPE KNIFE, WHICH WAS LOCATED IN A LOCKED POSITION (OPEN) IN THE CASE ATTACHED TO THE VEHICLE STEERING COLUMN, ONE KODAK AND ONE YASHICA CAMERA.

IT APPEARED THAT THE JEWELRY, MONEY, AND CAMERAS MAY HAVE BEEN TAKEN IN OTHER OFFENSES, THEREFORE SAME WAS PLACED INTO EVIDENCE PENDING FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION BY THE DETECTIVE BUREAU.

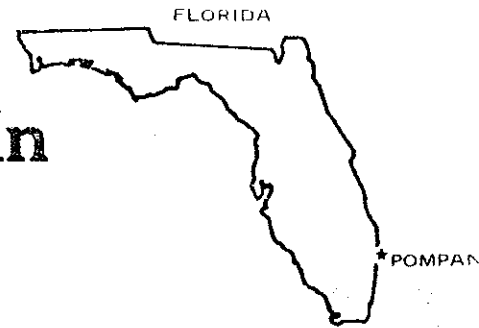

NOTE: SUBJECT-WM, LATE TWENTIES, SHORT DARK BROWN HAIR, SLENDER BUILD, TANNED, LSW-WHITE TEE SHIRT AND DARK BLUE PANTS.

MO-SUBJECT MASTURBATED IN FRONT OF VICTIMS AND ATTEMPTED TO GET VICTIMS TO DO SAME.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1824 HOURS, SATURDAY, 1/19/80, OFFICER CABLE WAS DISPATCHED TO MET WITH VICTIM AND HIS MOTHER. THE MOTHER STATED THAT THE ABOVE DESCRIBED WHITE MALE HAD ATTEMPTED TO ENTICE THE JUVENILES INTO THE VEHICLE AND ATTEMPTED TO REMOVE THEIR CLOTHES. THIS OFFICER SPOKE WITH VICTIM AND HE STATED THAT HE AND THE OTHER TWO VICTIMS WERE PLAYING FRISBEE IN THE CHURCH PARKING LOT WHEN THE VICTIMS WERE APPROACHED BY THE WHITE MALE AND HE PLAYED FRISBEE WITH THEM FOR AWHILE. THE SUBJECT AFTER A PERIOD OF TIME WENT TO HIS VAN. UPON ENTERING THE VAN HE CALLED THE THREE VICTIMS OVER AND ATTEMPTED TO ENTICE THEM INTO THE VAN WITH PLAYBOY TYPE PICTURES OF NAKED FEMALES. VICTIM STATED THAT HE KNEW WHAT THOSE PICTURES WERE AND DID NOT WANT ANY PART OF IT. THE SUBJECT THEN PULLED HIS PANTS DOWN AND MASTURBATED HIMSELF TO A CLIMAX AND THEN ENDEAVORED TO ENTICE THE VICTIMS TO DO THE SAME. VICTIM STATED THAT HE DID NOT ATTEMPT TO TOUCH HIM, BUT TRIED TO GET HIM INTO THE VEHICLE OR HE STATED HE WOULD "GET HIM". HE FURTHER STATED THAT THE OTHER TWO VICTIMS WERE IN THE VAN BUT NOTHING HAPPENED TO THEM.

THE TWO VICTIMS STATED THAT THEY WERE NOT IN THE VAN BUT VICTIM WAS IN THE VAN AND ALL THREE VICTIMS AGREE AFTER SOME PRODDING THAT THE SUBJECT ACTUALLY DID PULL VICTIM'S PANTS DOWN BUT DID NOT TOUCH HIM. THE JUVENILES WERE QUESTIONED WITH AND WITHOUT THE PRESENCE OF THEIR PARENTS AS IN SOME INSTANCES THEY APPEARED TO BE HESITANT TO ADVISE WHAT HAD HAPPENED. DETECTIVE BILL WAS CALLED TO THE SCENE AND THE INVESTIGATION IS TURNED OVER TO HIM AT THIS POINT. THE VICTIMS AND THEIR RESPECTIVE PARENTS CAME TO THE PD AND SPOKE TO DETECTIVE BILL. THERE IS NO FURTHER INFORMATION AT THIS TIME.
