During an interview on October 20, 1983 (See Inv. Report #4) Ottis TOOLE told Inv. Paul RUIZ and Det. TERRY that the police should find blood on the dock and the rest of the body should be found where the head was. Det. Sgt. Don COLEMAN, Indian River county Sheriff's Office, was consulted as he was the lead detective at the scene when Adam WALSH's partial remains were discovered. Det. Coleman advised that no forensic examination of the footbridge had been done and primarily because of a large and active alligator population an underwater search was not done. Further, for unexplainable reasons TOOLE's statements to RUIZ were not immediately communicated to Hollywood Police detectives. Examination of the footbridge is the subject of investigative memo #16 dated October 16, 1996.

After consultations with several authorities on the subject it was decided that an underwater search of the area was feasible and despite the passage of many years might still prove productive.

On Wednesday, February 12, 1997 an underwater search was conducted by the B.S.O. Dive Rescue Team. Some material, suspected to be bones, was recovered which required examination by the Broward County Medical Examiner. B.S.O. Deputy FERGUSON reports that he transported the bones to the Broward County Medical examiner's Office and was informed that the bones were of animal origin. FERGUSON further reports that this opinion was confirmed by a bone specialist.

Details of the dive mission are reported in enclosure l.
