On October 10, 1983, Reporting Agent responded to Jacksonville and met with AGENT BUDDY TERRY. AGENT TERRY introduced Reporting Agent to OTTIS ELWOOD TOOLE, W/M, DOB 3-5-47. TOOLE is an inmate at the County Jail, who has been charged with numerous murders throughout the Southeastern United States.

TOOLE waived his rights and spoke with Reporting Agent freely. Reporting Agent taped an interview, starting at 11:32 A.M. and lasting for approximately thirty (30) minutes. Shortly after Reporting Agent stopped the recording, TOOLE started a conversation regarding Ft. Lauderdale. As Reporting Agent was putting away the recorder, TOOLE asked "Are you from Ft. Lauderdale?" Reporting Agent said, "No." TOOLE, "Are you sure?" Reporting Agent, "Ottis for the last hour we have been talking about Cocoa, Cocoa Beach, and Rockledge. I introduced myself as an investigator from Brevard County." Reporting Agent then inquired of TOOLE. "You expecting someone from Ft. Lauderdale?" TOOLE, "Yeah, yeah I am.". Reporting Agent asked, "You get into something there?" TOOLE, "Yeah, I did."

Note should be made, TOOLE confessed to Reporting Agent about being present and/or taking part in what he believed to be approximately sixty five (65) murders. During this time, TOOLE was calm and produced an image of two people talking about the weather. During the brief conversation about Ft. Lauderdale, TOOLE completely changed. He held the sides of his chair, shifted from side to side, and started looking into the floor, which is something he didn't do before.

Reporting Agent felt due to TOOLE'S obvious nervousness about Ft. Lauderdale, it would be best not to pursue the matter, but to have AGENT TERRY do so. At the conclusion of the conversation, Reporting Agent met with AGENT TERRY and advised him about the conversation and TOOLE'S body language. Reporting Agent also brought up the ADAM WALSH death. Reporting Agent felt for a man to admit involvement in sixty five (65) murders, but get upset about Ft. Lauderdale, it had to be something appalling.

Reporting Agent contacted DETECTIVE JACK HOFFMAN from Hollywood Police Department on October 11, 1983 and advised him about the situation and referred him to AGENT TERRY.

Case closed.
