THE FOLLOWING IS THE FIRST SUPPLEMENT REPORT SUBMITTED BY DETECTIVE MARK SMITH.

AS OF AUGUST 1994, THIS DETECTIVE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED THE ABOVE CASE. SINCE BEING ASSIGNED THIS CASE, THIS DETECTIVE HAS FIELDED NUMEROUS CALLS REGARDING POSSIBLE SUSPECT INFORMATION. THE FACT THAT THESE CALLS HAVE OCCURRED HOWEVER, IS NOT UNUSUAL AS SINCE THE HOMICIDE, THIS AGENCY HAS RECEIVED MANY OF THE SAME TYPE CALLS.

ON 08/17/94. THIS DETECTIVE RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM A MANUAL MS. CASEY WAS INCLUDED IN THE ORIGINAL INVESTIGATION AND MUCH OF WHAT SHE TOLD THIS DETECTIVE HAD ALREADY BEEN COVERED IN THE ORIGINAL SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT. WHAT SHE DID INFORM THIS DETECTIVE IS THAT WHAT IS DIFFERENT IS THAT SHE BELIEVED WHAT SHE HAD OBSERVED WAS IN FACT AT THE SEARS MALL IN HOLLYWOOD, WHEN SHE HAD ORIGINALLY STATED THAT IT WAS ANOTHER STORE. HER INFORMATION HAD ALREADY BEEN INVESTIGATED AS SUCH; WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.

IN EARLY AUGUST OF THE SAME YEAR, THIS DETECTIVE REVIEWED THE CASE FILE OF THIS INVESTIGATION. BASED ON THIS REVIEW, THIS DETECTIVE SUBMITTED RECOMMENDATIONS TO SERGEANT DUNBAR, LIEUTENANT FUTCH, AND MAJOR MAHER. THESE RECOMMENDATIONS INCLUDED REVIEWING ALL EVIDENCE RELATING TO THE OTTIS TOOLE INVESTIGATION, AS WELL AS, A RE-INTERVIEW WITH PREVIOUSLY DOCUMENTED WITNESSES. BECAUSE OF THE LENGTH OF TIME SINCE THIS INCIDENT, THIS DETECTIVE BELIEVED IT TO BE DIFFICULT TO ATTEMPT TO ESTABLISH A NEW OR DIFFERENT MOTIVE FOR THE HOMICIDE, AND SOUGHT OUT TO SIMPLY EXPOUND UPON THE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED POSSIBLE MOTIVES AND SUSPECTS. NEW OR DIFFERENT MOTIVES WILL BE EXAMINED IF GENERATED.

A REVIEW OF THE EVIDENCE REVEALED THAT THE EVIDENCE PROPERTY OF THE EVIDENCE REVEALED THAT THE EXTREME REGARDING THE INVESTIGATION OF OTTIS TOOLE. VEHICLE, RECOVERED FROM WELLS BROTHERS USED CARS IN JACKSONVILLE ON 10/20/83, WAS BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN OPERATED BY OTTIS TOOLE DURING THE TIME THIS HOMICIDE/ABBUCTION WAS TO HAVE OCCURRED. NOTED IN EVIDENCE WERE PARTICIPATION OF THE THEORY PROTOGRAPHS SHOWN A CHIMMING OF THE IN AN AREA OF DRIVERS SIDE FRONT, AS WELL AS, THE DRIVER SIDE REAR FLOOR BOARD. IN ONE OF TOOLE STATEMENTS, HE HAD MENTIONED THAT HE PLACED THE SEVERED HEAD OF THE VICTIM ON THE REAR FLOORBGARD OF THIS VEHICLE AT ONE POINT BEFORE DISCARDING IT INTO THE WATERWAY ADJACENT TO THE FLORIDA TURNPIKE. PRESUMPTIVE BLOOD TESTS REVEALED THE PRESENCE OF BLOOD IN THE LUMINESCED areas of the carpet, as well as traces of being the traces previously ACCORDING TO THE FOLE LAB REPORT OF THESE TESTS PERFORMED IN MENTIONED. OCTOBER OF 1983: NO FURTHER TESTS COULD BE PERFORMED ON THESE ITEMS. SEVERAL YEARS BEFORE THE INCEPTION OF DNA, THIS MAY HAVE BEEN AN ACCURATE STATEMENT. THIS DETECTIVE MADE PHONE CONTACT WITH A WARMY, WHO HAS SINCE RETIRED AND CURRENTLY WORKING AT THE DUVAL COUNTY COURTHOUSE. DEPUTY TERRY HAD NO RECOLLECTION OF RECEIVING THE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED CARPET SAMPLES AND/OR PLACING THEM INTO PROPERTY AT THE JACKSONVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

CUSTODY OF THE HOLLYWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE DELIVERED BY THIS DETECTIVE, TO THE GENETIC DESIGN LABORATORY IN GREENSBORG, NORTH CAROLINA.

THIS DETECTIVE STOPPED AT THE JACKSONVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT PROPERTY EVIDENCE SECTION ENROUTE TO NORTH CAROLINA, AND WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF DEF. TERRY, ADDICAN ATTROCK TO LOCATE PAPER WORK ON THE ITEMS AND/OR THE ITEMS THEMSELVES.

ARRIVING OF THE GENETIC DESIGN LABORATORY FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXTRACTING DNA FOR POSSIBLE COMPARISONS WITH KNOWN SAMPLES OF THE VICTIM IN THIS CASE.

THE THOM STANDS OF THE WAR AND THE PURPOSE OF THE PACHETY.

WHEN THE STANDARD OF HEAD HAIR FROM THE VICTIM. THE TEST RESULTS WILL BE COVERED LATER IN THIS SUPPLEMENT REPORT.

THIS DETECTIVE HAD RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM A W/M BY THE NAME OF TERRY GREEN, PHONE #(407) 723-3700, OF MELBOURNE FLORIDA. MR. GREEN STATED THAT HE BELIEVED THAT HE SAW ADAM WALSH IN A BLUE FORD VAN AT A MR. DOUGHNUT ON BADCOCK ROAD IN MELBOURNE AFTER THE ABDUCTION. COULD NOT PROVIDE FURTHER INFORMATION REGARDING THE SUSPECT. IT IS THIS DETECTIVE'S OPINION AFTER SPEAKING WITH MR. GREEN ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS THAT HE APPEARS TO BE SOMEWHAT UNSTABLE AND CAN NOT PROVIDE WORTH WHILE INFORMATION AT THIS TIME, AND IT IS UNCLEAR ABOUT HIS SINCERITY. WILL NOT BE IGNORED, HOWEVER, AND FURTHER CONTACT WITH HIM MAY OCCUR IF IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT MR. GREEN DESCRIBES THE VICTIM WHEN HE OBSERVED HIM EXACTLY LIKE THE PICTURE OF THE VICTIM THAT HAD BEEN WHAT SHOULD FURTHER BE NOTED IS THAT THE FORD VAN CIRCULATED IN THE MEDIA. WAS ALSO THE VEHICLE PROVIDED TO THE MEDIA AS A POSSIBLE SUSPECT VEHICLE. ACCORDING TO THE SUPPLEMENT REPORT REVIEWED BY THIS DETECTIVE, A BLUE VAN WAS SEEN LEAVING THE AREA OF THE SEARS MALL ON THE DATE IN QUESTION. PERSONS OBSERVING THE VAN, PLACED ITS PRESENCE THERE AT APPROXIMATELY 1:30 P.M., WHICH WOULD HAVE BEEN APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR AFTER THE VICTIM WAS DISCOVERED MISSING.

SUBJECT WISHING TO REMAIN ANONYMOUS. THIS SUBJECT, LISTING A RECONTACT NUMBER OF 961-4862, STATED THAT HE BELIEVED HE OBSERVED THE ABDUCTION OF ADAM WALSH WHEN HE WAS AT THE SEARS STORE ON A SATURDAY EVENING AT APPROXIMATELY 8:30 P.M. THIS SUBJECT STATED THAT HE WORKED CONSTRUCTION AND THAT HE WAS AT SEARS PICKING UP CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT AND OBSERVED A HELICOPTER OVERHEAD. THIS SUBJECT FURTHER STATED THAT AS HE ENTERED SEARS, HE OBSERVED A W/M CARRYING A YOUNG W/M FROM INSIDE THE STORE; TOWARDS A

THIS CALLER STATED THAT HE BLUE VAN PARKED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STORE. WAS SURE THAT HE WAS THERE DURING THE EVENING, WHICH WOULD CONFLICT WITH THE REASON THE CALLER STATED THAT HE WAS THE EVIDENCE IN THIS CASE. CALLING ON THIS DATE IS THAT HE OBSERVED WHAT HE BELIEVED TO BE THE SAME THE CALLER STATED THAT VAN RECENTLY WESTBOUND ON SHERIDAN STREET AT 441. HE HAD WRITTEN DOWN THE TAG NUMBER BUT HAD LOST IT PRIOR TO CALLING. TOLD THAT THE TIMES HE REFERS TO, AS WELL AS, THE DAY OF THE WEEK HE MADE THESE OBSERVATIONS CONFLICT WITH THE EVIDENCE, THE CALLER STATED THAT HE WAS RELIEVED AND BELIEVED THEN THAT HE DID NOT ACTUALLY SEE THE ABDUCTION THE CALLER HAS RECALLED THIS DETECTIVE ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS IN QUESTION. STATING THAT HE MAY HAVE BEEN MISTAKEN AND MAY ACTUALLY HAVE BEEN AT SEARS AND WITNESSED THE ABDUCTION. THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE CALLER ABOUT THE POSSIBLE SUSPECT VEHICLE WAS VAGUE AND VERY LITTLE INFORMATION TO THE CALLER WAS ADVISED TO DOCUMENT A TAG NUMBER OF THE VEHICLE IF HE OBSERVED IT AGAIN AND RECONTACT THIS DETECTIVE.

MY WIGHT THE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED TESTS PERFORMED IN 1983, WHICH MAY HAVE CONSUMED ALL OF THE BLOOD, OR SIMPLY DUE TO THE LENGTH OF TIME THE ITEMS HAVE BEEN STORED. AS OF THIS SUPPLEMENT REPORT, THE ROUTER GUERY REVEALED THAT THE VEHICLE IN QUESTION IS PRESENTLY REGISTERED TO A COMPUTER QUERY REVEALED THAT THE VEHICLE EXPIRED IN 1985, AND HAD NOT BEEN RENEWED. A DRIVERS LICENSE CHECK REVEALED THIS INDIVIDUAL'S ADDRESS AT THIS TIME TO BE SO LOVETT STREET, IN ST. AUGUSTINE. ATTEMPTS WILL BE MADE TO LOCATE THIS VEHICLE SO FURTHER TESTING CAN BE PERFORMED TO ACQUIRE POSSIBLE EVIDENCE FOR FURTHER GENETIC TESTING.

BASED ON THE REVIEW OF THE INVESTIGATIVE FILE, IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE ORIGINAL INVESTIGATION INCLUDED AM EXHAUSTIVE INVESTIGATION INTO OTTIS TOTAL TOOLE CLAIMED TO HAVE DRIVEN THE TOOLE'S POSSIBLE INVOLVEMENT. CONFESSED TO THE ABBUCTION/HOMICIDE. PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED VEHICLE AND TO HAVE ABDUCTED A YOUNG W/M FROM A SEARS STORE NEAR FT. LAUDERDALE. ACCORDING TO THE INVESTIGATIVE FILE, TOOLE LED INVESTIGATORS TO AN AREA WITHIN THREE MILES OF WHERE THE SEVERED HEAD OF THE VICTIM IN THIS CASE WAS ACTUALLY FOUND. TOOLE DESCRIBED THIS AREA AS THE LOCATION HE DISMEMBERED THE HEAD FROM THE BODY WITH THE MACHETE WHICH WAS SIMILARLY DESCRIBED AS THE ONE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED IN THIS SUPPLEMENT TOOLE STATED THAT HE THEN DROVE NORTHBOUND ON THE TURNPIKE SEVERAL MILES BEFORE HE DISCARDED THE HEAD INTO THE WATERWAY ALONG THE ROADWAY. APPEARED THAT THESE STATEMENTS BY TOOLE WERE AS ACCURATE AS REASONABLY COULD BE EXPECTED FOR AN INCIDENT THAT HAD HAPPENED APPROXIMATELY TWO AND A DETECTIVES HOFFMAN AND HICKMAN INTERVIEWED SEVERAL HALF YEARS PREVIOUS. CELL MATES OF TOOLE'S REGUARDING TOOLE'S SINCERETY IN CONFESSING TO THIS HOMICIDE, AS WELL AS, TOOLE'S VIEWING OF A MOVIE OF THIS CASE WHICH HAD ALL INMATES INTERVIEWED STATED THAT THE MOVIE WAS RECENTLY AIRED ON TV. NOT VIEWED BY THEMSELVES OR TOOLE.

THE STATE OF THE INFORMATION OF SOME POSSIBILITY BEING THAT IF HE WAS FURNISHED WITH THE INFORMATION WITH SOMEONE HAVING SPECIFIC DETAILS FOR

SAFWAT IS LISTED AS THE LAST REGISTERED OWNER OF THE VEHICLE MENTIONED IN THE ORIGINAL INVESTIGATION WHICH MAY HAVE BEEN OPERATED BY OTTIS TOOLE AT THE TIME OF THE ABDUCTION/HOMICIDE. TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE RECORDS, SAFWAT OWNED THE 1971 CADILLAC, BUT SHOWED THAT THE REGISTRATION HAD NOT BEEN RENEWED SINCE 1985. APPROXIMATELY 1430 HOURS ON THIS DATE: THIS DETECTIVE MADE CONTACT WITH SAFWAT AT HIS RESIDENCE ON LOVETT STREET, MR. SAFWAT WAS INFORMED OF THE PURPOSE FOR THIS CONTACT AND STATED THAT HE REMEMBERED OWNING THE VEHICLE SAFWAT STATED THAT HE PURCHASED THE VEHICLE FROM AN UNKNOWN CAR DEALER IN JACKSONVILLE AND WAS TOLD BY THE DEALER THAT IT WAS THE VEHICLE PREVIOUSLY DRIVEN BY A HENRY LEE LUCAS AND OTTIS TOOLE. SAFWAT STATED THAT SOMETIME IN THE LATE 1980'S, HE HAD THE VEHICLE TOWED AWAY TO AN UNKNOWN JUNKYARD IN JACKSONVILLE. WENGT STATED THAT THE ADMINISTED DID DUST PARKE CAMPBETING FOR LT WHEN HE PURCHENDED TO CHECKED UNGUME IN AT THE A TRUNK LINER. BASED ON THIS INFORMATION, IT IS BELIEVED THAT THIS VEHICLE IS NO LONGER ACCESSIBLE AND ATTEMPTS TO LOCATE IT FOR THE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED TEST WOULD BE FUTILE. ONE MORE ATTEMPT WILL BE MADE TO LOCATE THE VEHICLE, HOWEVER, VIA A BODY FILE SEARCH WITH THE DEPARTMENT IF THE RESULTS OF THIS SEARCH ARE POSITIVE, A FOLLOW UP OF MOTOR VEHICLE. SUPPLEMENT REPORT REGARDING ITS RESULTS WILL BE GENERATED BY THIS DETECTIVE.

WASHINGTON REQUESTING TO TALK TO JOHN WALSH ABOUT THIS HOMICIDE. THIS TIPSTER LEFT HIS NAME, PETER GENOVESE, AS WELL AS A CONTACT NUMBER. THIS MESSAGE WAS RELAYED TO THIS DETECTIVE ON 03/16/95 AND THIS DETECTIVE MADE CONTACT WITH MR. GENOVESE. MR. GENOVESE STATED THAT HE BELIEVED A SUSPECT IN THE HOMICIDE OF A YOUNG W/F, FOUND ON A HOLLYWOOD GOLF COURSE IN 1980, MAY BE INVOLVED IN THE HOMICIDE OF ADAM WALSH.
