at 1 0'clock. Cause 1:00 o'clock seemed to be the time I was always there. I said, Fine, and I had it in the backof my mind athat I was going to drop Adam off at Grams and go straight over to the gym. And if Gram wasn't home Adam would come with me to the Gym. People at the G ym always said, Listen, if you want to bring him ..bring him but I never really wanted to because I though it was infringing on other people who were working out there ..but I thought if it was a slow afternoon I would bring him. So. since this has all happened I see my friends at the gym and they s aid they remembered that day, thinking Gee, I wonder what happened to Reve? She's usually here this time or she said she'd be here.. that was the only appointment that I had. I should have gone and gotten my driver's license.

- Q. Why wouldn't you have called your mother-in-law before you took Adam over there knowing you had a one o'clock appointment to be at the gym?
- A. Why wouldn't I/ Well. Gram is always available.. we've done it before.. just gone by and she might be hanging around the house. I didn't want her to stop what she was doing just for me.. I knew she wouldn't tell me that.. I thought it to be a casual thing; if she wasn't doing anything .. Fine.. if she was, then I would just take him.
- Q. Where did the grandmother live at that time?
