

Force and I have become acquainted, and he has told me.

or should I say bragged about kidnapping, sexual assault, and murder of young boys. I don't know whether to believe what he has said or take it with a grain of salt, because it is quite obvious to me that he has severe mental problems. He brags of such episodes in New Hangshire, Texas, and Florida, but has talked about the one in Florida more often and in more detail than the others. He is constantly saying that he wishes either Texas or Florida would put him on trial, because he could be executed in either one of those states, but is only facing several life sentences here in Nevada. He seems pre-occupied with the idea of being executed.

The boy he talks about in 7 lovide is adam Walsh, and he talks about kidnapping him, what he did to him, how he killed him, and an area in which he disposed of the body. I am not young into detail in writing, and will only tell what he has said, because I do not want to be in a position of having to go to court. As I have said, I am not sure whether he was in fact involved or if this is just his imagination working overtime, but should someone wish to talk to me I will tell them what

has been said.

For information of receiving offices; on January 30, 1986, at approximately 7:00 p.m., captioned age fifteen (15), who subject picked up was hitchhiking near Mesquite, Nevada. WARREN as a cook at a local restaurant. WARREN took to a desolate desert area near Mesquite, Nevada, threatened him with a knife, ordered him to completely disrobe and Captioned subject kept the sexually assaulted victim in his presence for approximately twenty-four (24) hours during which time he committed numerous sexual assaults which included oral and anal sex. During the incident, the victim was beaten repeatedly on the face and stomach. Captioned victim was transported in the trunk of WARREN'S vehicle and was taken to WARREN'S trailer during the night of January 30, 1986. During the sexual assaults, WARREN would cut a piece of the victim's hair as a symbolic jesture.

On January 31, 1986, at approximately 4:00 a.m., WARREN transported to an isolated area in Arizona near the Nevada border where WARREN attempted to kill by slashing his throat with a knife. The victim's throat was cut four or five times across the front. WARREN then hacked at the rear of the victim's neck in an attempt to decapitate him. "played dead" and was left in the desert area by WARREN after being covered by sage brush.

On January 31, 1986, at approximately 11:30 a.m.,
was found by a passing motorist near Littlefield, Arizona.
had walked approximately one mile from the location
where he was repeatedly knifed to the location where he
was found. WARREN was subsequently identified and arrested
by LAS VEGAS METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT (LVMPD) on
February 2, 1986, in the Mesquite, Nevada area for sexual
assault, kidnapping and attempted murder.

On February 6, 1986, WARREN gave a signed statement to LVMPD officers admitting the above offenses. During the statement WARREN indicated he has committed similar acts before, making reference to murders in St. Louis, New Hampshire, Dallas, Houston, and Florida. LVMPD has sent out a nationwide APB regarding captioned subject and his MO.

Las Vegas has obtained a copy of WARREN'S signed statement which will be forwarded upon request. Las Vegas will obtain a copy of WARREN'S recorded interview which was taken during the course of the signed statement. Las Vegas will review WARREN'S diary and advise appropriate offices of pertinent information.

Receiving offices are requested to review pending and unsolved closed kidnapping files, and to consider WARREN a suspect in crimes with similar MO's, i.e. male victims ten (10) to eighteen (18) years of age, sexually assaulted, clothing completely removed and subsequently burned, and victim's throat cut; possible decapitation.

Officer Whimple then transported suspect to Clark County Jail where he was met by Detective Peter Beckman. Suspect told Det. Beckman that he wanted to go out in a blaze of glory, and said that he wanted to die. He also told Det. Beckman that he had intended to commit suicide at his first possible opportunity. He also told Det. Beckman that he had taken a life of a second human being.

At approximately 1145 hours, Sgt. Samolovitch and I went to the Clark County Detention Center and contacted Keith Warren. Keith was in an isolation cell, nude. He was covered by a blanket. He was placed in isolation after his clothing was impounded and after making threats that he would commit suicide. Pending an observation period, he was not given anything which he may injure himself with.

I identified and introduced myself to him. I then advised him, verbally, of his Rights per the Miranda Decision. He stated that he understood his Rights and waived his Rights. He said he did not wish to have an attorney present while he talked with us, and he had no objections to talking about the incident. He spoke very concisely, and told Sgt. Samolovitch and I that he had indeed kidnapped a child. He believed the child's name was he said he had asked the child his name. He had repeatedly sexually assaulted him, and taken him to a desert area on old highway 91 and cut his throat, then thought he was dead. He returned and was unable to find him. He returned several other times that morning, and still was unable to find the victim.

He seemed as if he wanted a great deal of attention. I advised him that he was in control of the situation and requested his assistance in locating the various crime scenes which he had taken the victim to in the Mesquite, Bunkerville, and Arizona strip area. He told me that he would accompany us, to help us do our "homework", as he put it. He alluded to the fact, at that time, that he had killed a second victim, but declined to give any further details.

Clothing was obtained for him, and a belly-band handcuff chain was placed around his waist and the handcuffs were secured to his wrist. He was then transported to the LVMPD Juvenile Bureau.

Upon arrival, I readvised him of his Miranda Rights, via a pre-printed Rights Card. I asked if he read, wrote, and understood the English language, and he said that he did. I then asked him to read this Rights card to me out loud, which he did. I asked if he had any questions about his Rights, and he said that he had been through this numerous times before, and knew exactly what his Rights were. I then advised him that he did not have to say anything to us unless he wanted to, and if he wished to have an attorney present before talking to us, one would be provided for him, free of charge, if he could not afford one. He said he knew that. I then asked him to sign the card acknowledging that he understood his Rights. He asked if he had to sign the card, I told him he did not. He said that he would rather not sign anything. I then dated and timed the card and signed my own name to it, and placed "refused to sign" in the signature block for him.

In the subsequent conversation, Keith Warren told us that he had been out driving the car, which he had recently purchased from Harley's Garage in town, being a white Ford, and as he was nearing his residence, being Adam's Place, he observed a young white male juvenile who he recognized. He pulled up adjacent to the subject and asked him if he wanted a ride, he said that the chil got into the vehicle. They then drove out towards Abe Teerlink's place and got out of the vehicle. At that point, Keith produced to take all of his clothes off. At the time that a knife, and tol he had full intentions of sexually assaulting him. and Keith picked up to disrobe, he said that he caused killing him. After forcing to give him a head job, slang for fellatio. complied out of fear. Keith hair off with the knife. said that after he did that, he cut some of shoes and his own shoes. using shoe laces from 3 He then tied un back to his vehicle, put all of belongings into the He then took backseat of the vehicle, and drove to the area near the Riverside Bridge, not in the trunk of his vehicle. far from Teerlink's place, where he plac.

He then drove down to the Western Village to pick up Eric. He told not to make any noise while he was in the trunk, or he would kill him. He then spoke with JoAnn and told her about his car having problems. Apparently, the vehicle was burning a great deal of oil, and this upset him immensely. He then talked to Eric. Eric had to work late, and Eric advised that he would get a ride home from Mike. JoAnn had already departed and Keith then drove away in his vehicle.

He then drove out to the Wind Rivers, or Wind Acres, area, east of Mesquite. He went out a dirt road and walked , who was still nude, into the desert and was going to tie him to a fence post and leave him there. He changed his mind and strue numerous times in the face and stomach. He then forced to perform fellatio on him. He then took back to the vehicle, and placed him in the vehicle and drove him back to his trailer at the Adam's place.

When he arrived he saw that JoAnn's car was still there, that being JoAnn Krukow. He to to not to make any noise and poked him in the back with the knife and forced him into his camper/trailer. He then forced to perform fellation him, and then 69'd with him, wherein he performed rellation while the performed rellation on him. While there, he lubricated his finger with some Vaseline lotion and rubbed his back, and then slid his finger into butt. He tried to put his penis in butt, but didn't make penetration. He didn't try that again. Sometime after 2:00 AM, he tool out to the back of the trailer, and took a shovel along with him. He began to dig a hole but hit hard ground, and was unable to dig any farther. He was going to bury there.

Keith returned to his vehicle and gave him a pair of baggie blue pants and a gray and tan shirt to put on. He then put him in his vehicle and drove out to the Arizona strip, that being old highway 91. He parked the car on the left side of the highway, and walked back across the road, and down into a ravine adjacent to a hill there. Once there, he offered the knife and asked him if he wanted to do it himself, referring to killing himself. He then

changed his mind and began to strangl He then began to cut neck. He said he wasn't sure how many times he cut his neck, but knew it was quite a few, and he only cut on and around his neck, he didn't cut anywhere else. He said he did not get any blood on himself. Prior to cutting and strangling he did remove the clothing that had been wearing. He said he thoug was dead. He then walked back up to his car, and decided to go back and check on When he did so, he could not find him and began to think that was possibly still alive. He went back to his car again, and returned a few minutes later. Again, he could not find

He attempted to start his vehicle, and it wouldn't start. He was able to get help from someone near a ranch he believed was called the Advocado Ranch, or something to that effect, and a man driving a white 4-wheel drive vehicle came out to help him. Apparently, Keith's battery was dead and the subject jumped the vehicle.

Resident Officers are attempting to locate and identify that subject now, so that a statement might be obtained.

After he got his vehicle jumped, he drove the road in an attempt to locate the victim, without success. He then returned to Mesquite and purchased some oil for his vehicle, as it was still burning oil. He then drove back out Highway 91 attempting to locate the victim. He noted that there were some beehives on the road, near where he had left him. He then appropriate to ward the Wind Acre, or Wind River, area and burned all of J possessions and the clothes which he had allowed to wear.

He then went back to his residence at around 0800 hours. He saw JoAnn Krukow and her son, Thomas Adam, drive, by. He then went back to the trailer, and stayed there until approximately 1400 hours talking with Eric Brill, Rick, and other people.

He then left with Eric to go to the Lovelock LaPosada Restaurant to contact Gloria, who was the co-signer on his account. He could not withdraw money from the Credit Union in Virgin Valley without Gloria co-signing. They then went to the Credit Union, and he withdrew \$200 because he figured that he would have to be on the run. He already had approximately \$200 in his possession cashing his paycheck. After that, he spent time with Eric and Eric's girlfriend, Kirsten. They drove around, he purchased a case of Budweiser beer at the Stateline Casino. They took a friend of Eric's to work at the Western Village, then proceeded back towards the residence.

He saw the police vehicles there, and told Eric to keep on driving. He said that Eric asked him what was going on, and Keith told him that he had killed someone that night. Keith said that he said that because he didn't want to go on to a long explanation to Eric.

He also said that he wanted to see the Resident Officer, Clark Robison, "get off his fat, lazy ass".

He showed absolutely no remorse or regret about what he had done

He told us that he had killed another person, he was very reluctant to talk about that initially. We were able to determine that he said that after being spotted by Officer Robison, at approximately 0300 hours, on 2-1-86, he had hid in the median of I-15. He said that this loud mouth, big shot cowboy was riding a horse down in the gully, and had a rifle and a handgun with him, and that when this cowboy saw him, he said, "There you are you scum". At which time, Keith said he jumped up and stabbed this cowboy and pulled him off his horse, put him in the bushes, then unsaddled the horse and let it go. He said that he had the gun the cowboy had for a short time, but decided he didn't use those kind of things and got rid of them. He only like to use a knife, he told us. He said that he left the body there, and that it should be easy to find if we would do our "homework". I told him that it would be bery difficult for us to find a body in that kind of terrain and requested assistance. He declined to give any more specific details at that time.

I asked if he had done similar things like this before, and he said that he had. I attempted to determine where, when, and how many other incidents, he was taking responsibility for. He would not give any specifics.

During the search of his trailer, I did find a date book, which he had apparently been using for a Diary. In it were recepts from various locations, and notations that he had done quite a bit of traveling by hitchhiking, until he returned to Mesquite, several months ago, indicating that perhaps he had opportunity to commit other crimes in other localities.

Keith also told me that his father had began to sexually abuse him since he was approximately six years old, and continued until Keith was approximately 16 years old, when he decided that he had to runaway to escape this. Shortly thereafter, he was sexually assaulted on several occasions by persons on the road. Either people have pulled guns and knives on him and make him do sexual things. He also said that he was kidnapped by a bunch of bikers who took him into Montana, in the Blue Sky Country, as he put it, and repeatedly sexually assaulted him. He said that since that time, he has never been afraid of anybody because nothing worse could possibly happen to him. He said that he never told about what his father was doing because no one would ever believe him. He has told several adults in his life about what his father had done, and they said there was nothing that could be done to help him. He declined to say who these people he told were.

We then transported him from LVMPD to the McDonald's located on Las Vegas Boulevard and Lake Mead and purchased lunch for him. We ate lunch in the vehicle and followed by ID Specialist Atkins, who proceeded to the Mesquite

Upon arriving near the Riverside Bridge, on the Riverside Highway, we were met by Officer Robison. From there, Keith led us to the first location that he sexually assaulted the victim and cut his hair, that being on Abe Teerlink's Ranch. For specific location, please refer to previous officer's report. Once there, we found hair which was similar color to that of the victim's, 27 cents in coins, and a brown hylon wallet. Sgt. Samolovitch asked Keith about the wallet. Keith said that he had just bought the wallet a short time ago from Carter Store in Mesquite, and didn't know where he lost it, but that was definitely his wallet, he said. Sgt. Samolovitch asked him if it was a green wallet, and Keith told him, no, it was brown.

From that location, Keith showed us a general area where he stopped and put the victim in the trunk. There was nothing at that location to photograph or process.

We then proceeded to the location where Keith said that he cut the victim's throat. For that location, please refer to officer's report. Upon arriving, Keith directed us down a gulley on the east side of Old Highway 91, between two sets of beehives, and said he was down there in a small clearing adjacent to the marshy area. We located an area where there was wet ground. We felt that that was perhaps the location. We marked the area and continued to search. Keith said that he would be happy to come down and show us. He started down the hill where we found a blood-like substance adjacent to the first locale which we found. We also found a red shoe lace that was knotted in a loop, as well as blood-like substance and what was believed to be tissue or bone fragments Keith said that after he cut the victim's throat, he covered the victim up with broken branches, and that we should find broken branches there, which we did. It had apparently drizzled since the assault, and footprints in the area were somewhat distorted, so it was difficult to tell exactly what tread pattern of shoes had walked through. Keith indicated that the red laces were on a pair of boots which he was wearing at the time of the incident, and he had used them to tie the victim up, along with a lasso.

We then proceeded to the location where Keith tied the victim to a fence post. We marked that location, and as it was getting dark, we went to find the area where he burned the victim's clothing. We found that area. He said that it was near a small mound of dirt, and that he had covered over most of the debris but that some was still showing. When we arrived, we found some of the debris sticking out through a small mound of dirt, just as he had described. In addition we saw a tire track from a vehicle which had apparently made a U-turn there. He said that he had done just that, he had made a U-turn after burning the clothing he also said that as he was driving down the road, he threw a lasso out of the trunk, which he had forgotten to burn. Attempts to locate that were hampered by the darkness. He said he burned the victim's glasses, a calculator, his shoes and all the clothing. Fragments of these items were in fact located there.

We then returned and processed the scene where he had tied the victim to the post.

He told us that while the victim was in the trailer, he cried alot.

We spoke with him about the alleged homicide which he said he committed. He refused to give specific details, but did say that sooner or later we would find the body with his knife adjacent to it, and would know that he had done it. He said that he had purchased a set of knives from the Chief Chef of the Western Village Resort. He said the brand was Chef Master with black handles.

We returned Keith to the Mesquite Jail where Officer Whimple secured him. I thoroughly searched the cell prior to placing the suspect in, so that he would not have anything in which to injure himself with, if he still felt as if he wished to commit suicide. We unhandcuffed him, and removed the leg irons, and later returned with a meal for him. Earlier, he had told us that he wanted a steak for dinner from the Peppermill, being Western Village, and he said that he might show us where the body of the other victim was if we did that for him. I advised him at that time that if he wanted to cooperate, that was fine, but he would get his steak as requested no matter what he did for us that night. I advised him that we were not bribing him, or buying, his help, we were merely asking for his cooperation.

After he finished eating, we transported him back to Las Vegas Enroute to Las Vegas, I asked him how he felt about doing those things to He said he did not care, the child meant nothing to him. He said that after he knew the kid wasn't dead, he figured he had a 50-50 chance of surviving, and if God was with him, he would do it. He said, apparently God was with him. I asked him how he felt about the psychological trauma would feel, and he said it didn't make any difference anyway, he had people around to help him. He said why should he care about what he did to this kid because people have been doing that to him all his life. He honestly appeared to feel no remorse or regret for any acts he had done.

During the course of the day, I asked him if he would provide us with a written statement. He said he'd think about it. I advised him he'd probably have to write 15 or 20 pages to cover the incident fully. He said that was pretty long. I asked him about using a tape recorder to tape record his statement with him, he said he would never allow his voice to be tape recorded because a tape recorder had burned him one time. He went on to describe an incident where an attorney had tape recorded a sexual contact with him. He used that tape recording to black mail him with. Again, he refused to give specific details. He also said that he had lived with a man back East who had killed all those hitchhiking boys and buried them in the basement and his property. He said he didn't have any idea that this person was doing those things, and was glad that he wasn't one of his victims.

Keith kept saying that he wanted to go out in a blaze of glory and wanted to be executed. I explained to him, during our initial contact, that it would not be fair of him to try to escape or do anything else which would cause me to injure him, because I did not want to live with that on my conscience. He said that he did not want to go that way, he either wanted to be executed or take his own life.

He seemed fully aware of the seriousness of his acts and knew how wrong they were, but he still said that he wanted to shake up the community because of what they had done to him.

He was very concerned that one of his friends, named Eddy Olach, that being the person who identified himself as Jeffrey at the burned van scene, please see previous officer's report, was in trouble for harboring a fugitive, He said at no time did he have any contact with Eddy, either during the incident or after the incident prior to his apprehension. Eddy knew nothing about what was going on. He felt that Eddy was perhaps lying to protect him, and trying to throw us off track so that he would have more time to escape.

Eddy allowed officers to search his room at the Stateline Casino, room 3, for any property or items belonging to the suspect. None were found. There was no use in printing the room, as the suspect had been there on numerous previous occasions.

Upon returning the suspect to Las Vegas, I did advise him of the additional charges which he was being arrested for, and rebooked the suspect accordingly.

I additionally requested an extra set of FPC fingerprint cards to be completed so that I might forward them to the Federal Bureau of Investigations for comparison.

The suspect is currently wanted in New Hampshire for a weapons violation, however, on the NCIC incident, it does state they would only extradite in the eastern seaboard states. I will teletype them and advise them of the suspect's whereabouts.

Thoele, Utah, authorities will be advised, and attempts were made to contact Jay Lee Campbell in order to obtain a statement from him. Nevada Resident Deputies are also attempting to locate the cave where Keith was supposed to be hiding in, and will attempt to obtain a statement from the cook at the Western Village with whom Keith had an argument with preceeding the kidnapping. We will also the contact the personnel at Carter's market in an attempt to determine when the wallet was sold to Keith, and verify that he had purchased oil there after the attempted murder.

I contacted Deputy Bailey and advised him that the District Attorney's office in Las Vegas had said that due to the continuing nature of this crime, we would be able to seek prosecution of the attempt murder. He said that would be acceptable, and he would verify that fact with the Mojave County Attorney's Office, due to the fact that criminal incident originated in Nevada, and both of the crimes occurred in Nevada, with the Attempt murder occurring in Arizona.

Additionally, the bulk of the investigation had been conducted by LVMPD with Deputy Bailey's full assistance and cooperation.

In the course of the conversations, Keith also alleged that he had seen a person whom he lived with, that being Ray Hoppes, sexually abuse his children on numerous previous occasions. He said that the Welfare people had taken the kids out of the residence, and had returned several of the kids to Ray Hoppes, and he felt that he was still sexually abusing them. There were diary entries in Keith's date book when the children were taken into custody, and that he was trying to help Ray get the kids back.

I have since contacted Nevada State Welfare, and they had advised us that Keith Warren was in fact a character witness for the Hoppes during these proceedings.

The investigation is continuing. The ATLs and teletypes have been cancelled. The press release has been updated, and numerous media representatives have contacted the LVMPD Sexual Assault Office requesting additional information to this matter.

At this time, the victim is at Sunrise Hospital in room 305 East, where he is undergoing examination for possible neurological damage due to the hacking on the back of his neck. His condition is continually improving, and he was able to walk and take a shower today. I will attempt a further interview with him for more complete details tomorrow.

It should be noted that Keith was extremely frightened about having the media involved. He said that he did not want to talk to any media people without an attorney being with him. I assured him that we would not allow any representative of the media to contact him at this time.

Keith also said that he has been having sex with an 18 year old male in Mesquite Bunkerville area consentually, but refused to identify this person also.

With initial interviews with suspect KEITH WARREN, he indicated that he had firsthand knowledge of a subject named RAY HOOPES who resides in Mesquite, Nv. sexually abusing his children. Subsequently I contacted Nevada State Welfare and spoke with case worker MARK FITTGERALD who advised me that he was aware of the case and that the lidren had been removed from the residence several months back due to physical abuse. He stated that sexual abuse was suspected but could never be confirmed. As such he requested that I reinterview the ildren in reference to this.

On 2/5/86 MARK FITZGERALD and I spoke with an They related numerous incidents of physical abuse but never any information on sexual abuse.

I also interviewed who spent a great deal of time with suspect WARRED is repeatedly mentioned in WARREN's date book and WARDEN's was apparently working with him on stopping him to wet the bed.

stated that WARREN would pumish him by making him carry large buckets of water up and down hills but at no time was there ever any sexual contact.

On 2/6/86 DET. MC LAUGHLIN and I contacted KEITH WARREN at the Clark County Detention Center. I advised him of his rights per the Miranda Decision via a preprinted rights card which he declined to sign. However, he did state he understood his rights and did knowingly waive his rights. He stated that he did want to talk with us but he did not want to sign anything at that time I advised him previously that I had wished to take a taperecorded statement from him to detail all of the different occurrences which he had previously advised us about. He initially stated he would not do that; however, he contacted me and stated that he was willing to do that at this time.

WARREN told me that he would make the statement if I called his mother and allowed him to talk with her. His mother's name is CLAIRE DRIVAS. Her telephone number is (617) 475-2242. I advised him that whether or not he gave me a statement made no difference as I would contact his mother for him and allow him to speak with her if at all possible. I stated that makin a telephone call was not a condition of making a statement. If he wished to do so, he should tell me at that time. He told me he did wish to give me a statement. At that time we reviewed his rights per Miranda via the preprinted rights form on a statement. He signed the rights acknowledgement and waiver section.

I attempted to place a call to his mother for him without success. I advised him that I would return and attempt to contact his mother again on Saturday, 2/8/86.

DET. MICHAEL MC LAUGHLIN, P#541 witnessed the above. While I was attempting to make the telephone call to his mother, WARREN told DET. MC LAUGHLIN that his father made him have his hair cut short and have white sidewalls around his ears and that perhaps this was the reason why he cut the victim's hair.

DET. MC LAUGHLIN departed. I then initiated a tape recorded statement with WARREN. I spoke with WARREN about his involvement with what occurred during that incident and also about other crimes which he stated he had committed. He described to me two homicides which he committed in St. Louis, Missouri. He was fairly specific about certain details and very vague on others. However, the method of operation which he described was identical to that employed with

He also admitted to committing a homicide in or around Oliverona, Florida in the Florida Keys area where he cut his subject's throat. He said the subject's name was and then dropped s body into the ocean.

In my conversations with him I was able to determine that he preferred to victimize young white males with long, dark colored hair, primarily those persons living on the street so to speak. He said he liked them to, "talk tough." He said that he would initially befriend his potential victim and would provide them with beer or food or temporary shelter and in the course of that have voluntary sexual contact with them. At some point in his contact with them he would kidnap them by the use of a knife and force them to perform more sex acts with him and he would detain them for longperiods of time. At some point he would cut their hair with the knife. Then later he would kill them normally by cutting their throat. He said some he would cut the throat and stab them in the back and then dispose of the mude body and burn any possessions that the person might have had.

For complete details please refer to KEITH WARREN's transcribed statement.

On 2/8/86 I returned and visited KEITH ALAN WARREN at the Clark County Detention Center with his statement which had been transcribed. He reviewed the statement with me after I had readvised him of his rights. He said everything appeared pretty good and that's exactly what he did say, but did refuse to sign the statement.

Prior to initiating this interview I was able to contact his mother, CLAIRE DRIVAS and allowed him to speak with her. She then wanted to speak with me and advised me that she really didn't want to know what her son was doing or had done.

On 1-31-86, at approximately 1130 hours, SHANE HOPPES, was in the desert area near Mile Marker 5, of Old Highway 91, between Mesouite. and Littlefield, when he observed someone whom he recognized the desert, nude and bleeding from wounds on his throat and neck.

and then proceeded CAMPBELL provided immediate assistance t back to town, in order to get help. There he contacted DEE J. CAMPBELL, who was visiting friends in Mesquite. CAMPBELL returned with his Pick-Up truck, and wrat in a sleeping bag and a jacket. He then transpor :0 a service station in Mesquite, where the Police and an ambulance were requested.

OFFICER CLARK ROBISON, LYMPD, and DEPUTY STEVE BAILEY, Mohave County Sheriff's Office arrived.

The victim was able to communicate with them, even though he was seriously injured. The victim advised OFFICER ROBISON that the red-haired cook from the Peppermill had picked him up, made him do what girls do, and then taken him into the desert and cut his throat.

OFFICER ROBISON recognized the description provided by as matching that of a person known to him as KEITH, whom he had contacted approximately 2 weeks prior to this incident.

was subsequently transported to the Dixie Medical Center, in St. George, Utah, where he was treated by Doctors NEUBERGER, FOXLEY, and WINTICH, who were assisted by Registerned Nurses WALLACE, McCALL, and DAVIES.

Detectives DESPAIN and RODGERS of the St. George Police Department were present.

DETECTIVE RODGERS took photographs of injuries with a 35 milimeter camera. DR. NEUBERGER advised that the victim's condition was extremely serious, near death.

It appeared to him that throat had been cut with a sharp object, numerous times, on the front, sides, and back.

He stated that the victim had lost a great deal of blood. He then advised that the victim must undergo surgery immediately, in order to save his life.

Subsequent to emergency surgery, DR. NEUBERGER completed a St. George Police Department Sexual Assault Kit, and released this to DETECTIVE DESPAIN, who in turn, impounded this item.

DETECTIVES DESPAIN and RODGERS also impounded the sleeping bag and blue jacket which the victim had been wrapped in, as well as the bedding from the Ambulance in which the victim was transported.

OFFICER R. H. LOWTHER of the Arizona Department of Public Safety, took a brief, tape-recorded statement from SHANE HOPPES, as to locating the victim. DEE CAMPBELL apparently departed.

At approximately 1206 hours, LYMPD Dispatch advised the Sexual Assault Unit of this incident.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH and I initiated our investigation.

OFFICER ROBISON, assisted by SGT. THORNTON, and OFFICER FISCH, contacted the Peppermill Restaurant at the Western Village resort and were able to determine that the red-haired cook's last name was WARREN, and his first name was KEITH, as OFFICER ROBISON had suspected.

OFFICER ROBISON proceeded to KEITH WARREN's known address, that being a trailer located to the rear of 450 Riverside Highway, in Bunkerville/ Mesquite, also known as the ADAMS PLACE.

Upon arriving, they observed a 1976 Ford Torino, white in color, having no license plates with VIN 6H27H208908, parked adjacent to WARREN's trailer.

They also observed a Dealers Report of Sale in the window, indicating that the vehicle had been sold to WARREN on 1-30-86.

Upon examining the vehicle from the exterior, they observed what appeared to be a blood-like substance, on the front seat of the vehicle, as well as clothing, in the rear of the vehicle.

WARREN was no where to be found.

They confirmed with the occupants of the residence, that WARREN did, indeed, live in that trailer.

OFFICER ROBISON also advised that at approximately 0600 hours, on 1-31-86, mother, had filed a Missing Person/Runaway Juvenile report, under D.R. Number 86-41707, alleging that her sc had departed the residence enroute to a basketball game, in Mesquite, at approximately 1900 hours on 1-30-86, and had not been seen nor heard from since.

Based on this information, and the likelihood that KEITH WARREN may be involved in this crime, and the possibility there may be perishable evidence, I advised OFFICER ROBISON and SGT. DETECTIVE SGT. SAMOLOVITCH and I then contacted DEPUTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY WILLIAM HENRY, and advised him of the circumstances, known to us at this time.

He stated there appeared to be sufficient facts to warrant the issuance of a Search Warrant for the vehicle, and camper/trailer.

An Affidavit for Warrant was prepared, and a Warrant was formulated, requesting authorization to search the vehicle, and the above-listed Coleman Tent/Trailer.

That the search be directed to obtain any evidence, clothing or instrumentality of this crime. Once this Warrant was prepared, it was presented to JUDGE MYRON LEAVITT.

JUDGE LEAVITT reviewed these Documents, and provided authorization for the search.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH and I proceeded to the LVMPD Criminalistics Laboratory in order to contact ID SPECIALIST KATHY ADKINS, P#900, who was to accompany us to Mesquite, Nevada, in order to serve this Warrant.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH and I arrived at the Evidence Vault, and contacted Specialist ADKINS. At approximately 1725 hours, J. LEE BISHOP, the Proprietor of the Arrowhead Service Station, in Arrowhead, Nevada, telephone 864-2260, arrived at the Criminalistics Section at the Labratory, with the 1976 Ford, owned by WARREN, in tow.

We noted that the 4 doors to the vehicle, and the trunk, were sealed with LVMPD Evidence Stickers. The vehicle was then placed into the Labratory garage and the garage was secured.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH, SPECIALIST ADKINS and I then proceeded to Mesquite.

We arrived at the ADAMS PLACE, 450 Riverside Highway, and contacted OFFICER ROBISON, who had stood by the scene.

While SPECIALIST ADKINS was processing and searching the camper for possible evidence, SGT. SAMOLOVITCH and I interviewed the occupants of the residence, situated next to the camper.

We spoke with JEANNE ANDERSON, THOMAS ADAMS, and JOAN KRUKOW. JOAN has lived in the area for a number of years. Her mother, JEANNE is currently living with her, as well as her son, THOMAS.

They advised us that KEITH had moved on to their property with his camper, approximately 2 weeks prior to this incident, that being the same night that OFFICER ROBISON contacted KEITH WARREN, and that KEITH has resided in the camper adjacent to the residence since that time.

They advised that on the morning of 1-30-86, at approximately 0800 hours, KEITH had made breakfast for them. That after breakfast, MISS KRUKOW and KEITH went to Mesquite, spoke with Y.L. HUGHES in reference to buying another trailer for the property.

They then proceeded to the Western Village where they are both employed and picked up their pay checks.

KEITH remained at the Western Village while JOAN left.

She was returning at approximately 1400 hours, that day, when she observed a white vehicle pull up behind her, being driven by KEITH. He told her that he had just purchased the vehicle, at Harley's Garage.

She returned home prior to 1500 hours, and prepared to go to work.

She remained at work until 1700 hours.

MS. KRUKOW remained at her residence with her son, THOMAS, who was quite ill, for the remainder of the evening. KEITH did not come home.

She returned to the Peppermill, at approximately 2300 hours, in order to pick up ERIC GRILL, who was residing at her residence. When she arrived, she met with KEITH who was driving his vehicle. KEITH told JOAN that he was supposed to pick ERIC up, and said that his car was burning oil. He showed her his hands, and they were oily and greasy.

ERIC GRILL came out of the restaurant, and said that he had to stay approximately a half hour later, and KEITH would bring him home. She advised him that KEITH had been there, and had been having trouble with his car. KEITH had departed.

She awoke at approximately 0800 hours, on 1-31-86, in order to take her son, THOMAS, to the doctor. She noted that KEITH's vehicle was not there.

TOM related that while his mother was driving him to the doctor's office, he observed KEITH drive by in his new vehicle, heading back toward the residence.

When MISS KRUKOW returned home, at approximately 1130 hours, neither KEITH, nor the vehicle were at the residence. She departed for Las Vegas, and returned at approximately 1630 hours. At that time, OFFICER ROBISON was there.

In subsequent conversation, we were able to determine that ERIC had seen KEITH on 1-30-86, at approximately 1500 hours, at the Peppermill. That KEITH had an argument with one of the cooks who told KEITH to take the night off.

KEITH departed at that time, and said that he would return, at approximately 2200 hours, that evening, to pick him up.

Apparently KEITH did return, along with JOANNE in separate vehicles. KEITH told ERIC that he had had car trouble. He then departed.

ERIC did not see KEITH until approximately 1100 hours, 1-31-86. They got KEITH's paycheck cashed at approximately 1300 hours, and then drove to the medical office, at approximately 1500 hours, so that ERIC could obtain medical treatment for injuries to his hands.

They were told to return at 1700 hours.

They then proceeded and contacted a subject named JACK WOLF, and JACK asked for a ride to work. KEITH asked ERIC to stop at the Stateline Bar so that he could buy some beer. KEITH purchased a case of Budweiser in bottles, and ERIC put the beer in the trunk of the vehicle.

After they had taken to work, they were driving back toward their residence, from the Peppermill, and KEITH told ERIC, that: "If there are any cops there, keep going."

They was a black and white, probably OFFICER ROBISON's vehicle, parked at the residence. ERIC drove by the residence, as KEITH had requested, toward the Riverside Bridge.

ERIC asked KEITH what was going on, and KEITH said that he had killed somebody last night. ERIC then stopped the car, KEITH got his beer, placed it in a gulley beside the road, and took other beer and placed it into a small bag which he was carrying and walked into the desert.

At that time, ERIC said that KEITH was wearing a blue jacket, tan jeans, a white T-shirt, and shoes.

KIRSTEN was in the vehicle with the subjects during their conversations. She was with them, when KEITH purchased the beer, and made the statements to ERIC. KEITH complained bitterly about his car, breaking down.

She became extremely frightened when KEITH said that he had killed someone last night. She said that he exited the vehicle, in the desert area, and placed the beer in the gulley and that he was carrying a Western Village bag, white in color, with him at that time, apparently the same bag that he always carried.

He put a portion of the beer into the bag, and departed into the desert.

ERIC and KIRSTEN then returned to the Medical Center where ERIC received treatment for his infected fingers, prior to returning to his residence.

Voluntary Statements were obtained from all the above subjects.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH wrote ERIC's statement at his request, because his hands were incapacitated temporarily, due to minor surgery and bandaging.

I wrote the statement for MRS. ANDERSON, because she stated her vision was impaired.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH then transported ERIC and KIRSTEN in an attempt to locate the area where they had dropped KEITH off. They were able to find the general area, but unable to locate the beer at that time.

While SGT. SAMOLOVITCH was gone, I assisted SPECIALIST ADKINS in searching the trailer. SPECIALIST ADKINS had recovered hair, which appeared to have been cut, in the camper, as well as a used prophylactic clothing, shoes, knotted shoe strings, a nude male model-type magazine, a vibrator, vaseline, a box of knives, cigarette butts, bedding, and a brown date-type book, which appears to have been used as a diary by KEITH WARREN.

Additionally, there were various papers with KEITH WARREN's name on them, indicating that he did reside in that trailer, or camper. Please refer to SPECIALIST ADKINS' Property Impound reports and the Search Warrant Return for more complete details.

During the search of the residence, various addresses were located, including the address of WARREN's mother, and that of a Pen Pal, named CARLA FLANDERS, of 473 Brook Avenue, Tooele, Utah, 84074.

SPECIALIST ADKINS completed her search and processing of the trailer. She also recovered latent fingerprints off various locations inside.

We were then advised that SGT. THORNTON and OFFICER ROBISON had apparently located a case of Budweiser beer, adjacent to the Riverside Freeway, between the ADAMS PLACE and the Riverside Bridge. We proceeded to that location.

SPECIALIST ADKINS photographed the location of these items, and impounded them.

Due to the terrain features of this area, it would be extremely difficult for someone to transverse the area between the Riverside Highway and Interstate 15, due to the river and thick brush.

SGT. THORNTON requested Air II to respond and sweep the area, in an attempt to locate the suspect.

A K-9 Unit was requested to respond from town, that being OFFICER TOM HARRINGTON.

Upon OFFICER HARRINGTON's arrival, he began a foot search of the area, and found a white duffle bag, a short distance from the Highway, on a hill, above the gulley where the beer was found.

Inside this bag were numerous knives. There was also broken glass adjacent to the bag, and there was bottled Budweiser in the bag.

SPECIALIST ADKINS photographed these items and impounded them for further processing.

Subsequent to the initiation of the foot search, SGT. SAMOLOVITCH, SPECIALIST ADKINS, and I, departed the scene of the search, in order to return to Las Vegas, to complete the processing of the evidence, and the vehicle at the Labratory.

We returned to Las Vegas at approximately 0300 hours. At that time, I issued an Attempt To Locate, a Press Release, and a Nationwide Broadcast, in reference to this incident. All Officers in Clark County, of all jurisdictions were notified of what had occurred.

Numerous photographs of the suspect had been distributed to the Resident Officers at Mesquite, Mesquite Police Department, and the Highway Patrol in the area, and attempt to locate the suspect.

I returned to the office at approximately 0930 hours on 2-1-86. I was advised at that time, that the victim was improving, and the Doctor had authorized Officers to interview him.

At that time, the information that we had available to us, indicated that the Kidnapping and possibly a majority of the crimes occurred in our jurisdiction, and that the Attempt Homicide did apparently occur 5 miles into Mohave County, Arizona.

As such, DEPUTY BAILEY requested the assistance of the Sexual Assault Unit in investigation of this matter, due to it's complexity and

multi-jurisdictional facets. I completed a photographic lineup, consisting of 6 LVMPD booking photos, including a photo of KEITH WARREN.

The following identification numbers were used:

645355, 125649, 645055, 287977, 435938, and 203303.

WARREN's photo was positioned as number three, out of the six.

These photos were then attached to a manila folder, with a piece of white paper taped across the bottom of each photo concealing the numbers. These photos were numbered 1 through 6, as noted above.

I then proceeded to the Mesquite area. I was advised by OFFICER ROBISON that SWAT members had combed the area surrounding the location that the beer was found, with negative results.

Additionally, OFFICER ROBISON had observed someone whom he had thought to be KEITH WARREN, adjacent to I-15, at approximately 0300 hours, 2-1-86. At that time, the searching was moved to that location.

The area was searched with negative results.

SWAT concluded their operations at approximately 1300 hours. A road block had been established on I-15, with negative results.

I continued to the Dixie Medical Center, in St. George, Utah, accompanied by DEPUTY BAILEY. DEPUTY BAILEY advised me that the victim's condition continued to improve and that the Attending Physician, DR. NEUBERGER, had consented to allow us 20 minutes interview with the victim.

I then spoke with a representative of the St. George Sentinel, and provided him with a copy of the Press Release, and some of the additional information available.

I also provided him with a copy of the photograph of WARREN and requested that he print that photograph and request the public's assistance in locating WARREN.

Once inside the medical center, I contacted the victim's mother,
She advised me that was able to communicate and had told her that the man who picked nim up, called him by name.

That the man held a knife on him, and told him that he would cut his throat if he didn't do what he wanted. That the man took him to the trailer at the ADAMS PLACE. That the man transported him in the trunk of his car to various locations, and that the man took him into a ditch, tried to strangle him, and then cut his throat. That the man left several times, and returned, apparently looking for him.

told her that he had lost consciousness, several times, and had onen crawled up the hill, where HOOPES had come in contact with him.

I obtained a statement from

DEPUTY BAILEY. NURSE DEANNA MURRAY, and I then entered the Hospital room of I noted that his hair was cut very unevenly.

I noted that he was extremely pale and seemed weak. There was a great deal of bandaging and packing around his neck.

There were intravenous tubes in both of his arms. I noted his voice was very hoarse.

He said that he was in a great deal of pain.

After introducing myself, I read him the instructions on a Photographic Lineup Identification form. He stated that he was unable to sign, due to his injuries.

I then showed him the photographic lineup, which I had prepared. He immediately chose photograph #3, that being the photograph depicting WARREN.

He said that he was positive that was the person that had done the things to him.

He was unable to sign the rear of the photograph. I signed the rear of the photograph, and dated it 1405 hours. I also requested DEPUTY BAILEY to sign the photograph. He timed it 1505 hours, due to the one-hour time difference, between Arizona and Nevada. My watch remained on Nevada time, throughout this incident.

I then took a tape-recorded statement from sequently transcribed, and was 16 pages long.

They again departed, and went to the ADAMS PLACE, that being the location where WARREN's trailer is parked.

The suspect removed from the trunk, pressed a knife-point into his back, and forced him inside the camper. Once inside the camper, the suspect caused to lay on the bed, and then untied him.

The suspect then force to again perform fellatio on him, and told him that if he did not make him come, he would kill him, and he set a 2:00 A.M. time limit on that.

He then caused to get into a position, called an 86, wherein he was forced to perform fellatio on the suspect, while the suspect performed fellatio on him.

obtained from the victim, were available at his office.

I returned with DETECTIVE DESPAIN to the St. George Police Department where I obtained the above-listed items.

I provided DETECTIVE DESPAIN with a copy of the LVMPD Property Impound report, which I had completed for these items.

I then went enroute to Las Vegas from St. George, at which time, I overheard an LVMPD Dispatch requesting the Resident Officer from Mesquite, respond to the Arizona/Nevada border to assist the Volunteer Fire Department who was the in the process of putting out a vehicle fire, and was having difficulty with combative intoxicated persons at the scene.

I contacted the personnel from the Mesquite Volunteer Fire Department.

They were standing beside a Ford Van bearing California License plates, which was partially destroyed by fire. There were 2 intoxicated subjects sitting beside the Van.

One identified himself as RUDY ILDEFONSO, date of birth, 7-14-51. The other one would only identify himself as JEFFERY. He was extremely belligerent and continued to make threats to the Fire Department Officials and I.

Both subjects were extremely intoxicated and had great difficulty in standing.

JEFFERY continued to ask if we wanted to Fight and if we wanted to hit him. He was advised that we did not, we were merely investigating the presence of the vehicle.

The Fire Department Officials advised that the original persons who had called the burning Van in, had observed 2 subjects run from the Van, into the desert. They were unable to identify those persons.

OFFICERS from the Nevada Highway Patrol arrived to assist.

The Van was registered to a RAYMOND CARRARA in Sacramento, California. Neither of the subjects present would provide any information as to how the vehicle arrived at that location, who was driving it, or where the owner currently was. The Nevada Highway Patrol Sergeant on the scene, then told me that JEFFREY had said that he had spent some time with KEITH on that date, and that he thought that KEITH was innocent.

He said that KEITH was currently at room #3, at the Stateline Motel, which is where he resides.

He then said that KEITH was currently at the residence, where he lived, being the ADAMS PLACE.

We requested assistance, and OFFICER CARL LAMB, assisted by OFFICER WIMPLEY from the Mesquite Police Department, checked those two locations. Both proved to be false.

In that the burned Van was on the Arizona side of the line, Arizona was requested to respond, however, were unable to do so. As such, then the 2 Highway Patrol Officers on the scene, decided to transport both RUDY and JEFFERY to Mesquite, so that they would not endanger their lives or the lives of others by exposing themselves to on-coming traffic.

Upon arriving at Mesquite, OFFICER LAMB interviewed both subjects. Apparently a 3rd subject was at the Western Village, creating a disturbance. It appeared that he had departed the Van, and hitch-hiked back to Mesquite, prior to the arrival of the Nevada Highway Patrol at the scene.

This subject was arrested by OFFICER LAMB, for Public Nuisance. The other 2 subjects, RUDY and JEFFREY, were at that time, taken into his custody for Civil Protective Custody, due to their extremely intoxicated state.

We checked ever possible lead, tying the subject identifying himself as JEFFREY to KEITH at that time. Apparently JEFFREY also worked at Western Village. No further leads could be developed. I then returned to Las Vegas.

At 0555 hours, on 2-2-86, I was advised by LYMPD Dispatch that KEITH WARREN had been taken into custody by OFFICER SIMPLEY at the Western Village in Mesquite, and had been booked at the Clark County Jail, on one count of Kidnapping and one count of Sexual Assault.

I proceeded to the Detective Bureau and contacted SGT. SAMOLOVITCH, and then DETECTIVE PETER BECKMAN, P#212.

DETECTIVE BECKMAN had met OFFICER WIMPLEY at the Clark County Jail, and assisted in booking the subject. DETECTIVE BECKMAN impounded the clothing which the suspect was wearing and completed an LVMPD Hair Collection Kit.

DETECTIVE BECKMAN also found an identification card for a subject named PATRICK BRILLEY, Metro ID# 827831, in WARREN's possession, which he also impounded.

OFFICER WIMPLEY advised DETECTIVE BECKMAN that at approximately 0015 hours, 2-2-86, he received a telephone call from the Security Guards at the Western Village, those being HOWELL MIFFLIN, FRANCIS LYTLE, JOHN THOMAS, and ROBERT PERKINS, that they had observed KEITH being KEITH WARREN, enter the restroom facilities, at the Western Village RV Parking area.

The Security Officers had locked the suspect inside the facility.

OFFICER WIMPLEY responded and ordered WARREN to come out. WARREN then slid a knife under the door, of the facility, which DETECTIVE BECKMAN later impounded.

WARREN then gave himself up, saying that he didn't have a knife, and WIMPLEY couldn't shoot him any more.

OFFICER ROBISON advised WARREN of his Rights per the Miranda Decision. WARREN apparently waived his Rights and told OFFICER ROBISON, that he had committed the crimes of which he was accused.

He also said that if we looked for it, we would find something on the Highway, which would get him the death penalty. He refused to elaborate on that, at that time.

He told OFFICER ROBISON that he had done this because he was so upset about the cars that he had bought. He then told OFFICER ROBISON about how he had eluded capture.

He also confirmed that that was him that OFFICER ROBISON had observed by the Freeway, at approximately 0300 hours, the preceeding day.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH and I later proceeded to the Clark County Detention Center, and contacted WARREN. WARREN had apparently stated that he wanted to go out in a blaze of glory, and commit Suicide.

As such, his clothing was removed and he was placed in Protective Custody, Isolation, in the Jail facility.

I advised WARREN of his Rights per the Miranda Decision, verbally.

He stated that he understood his Rights. He stated that he did wish to speak with us, without his Attorney being present, thus waiving his Rights.

I advised him that we wished his help in finding the various scenes which he had been at, with the victim. He agreed. For full details of the statements made by WARREN, please refer to a following Officer's Report, under the same D.R. Number.

WARREN subsequently confessed to committing this crime, and agreed to show these Officers the various locations.

He was then returned to the LVMPD Detective Bureau, where he was further interviewed. He gave specific details on the commission of the crime, which corresponded with those, given by the victim.

Additionally, he alleged that during the time the Road Block was set up, on 2-1-86, being after 0300 hours, he had observed a "loud-mouthed cowboy" riding a horse in the median area, between the north and southbound lanes of I-15, and that he k ad approached the subject from the rear, had stabbed and killed him.

He also alleged that he had committed numerous other crimes, of a similar nature to that perpetrated on

He declined to give a written statement and said that he did not want to have his voice tape-recorded.

Prior to any questioning that was attempted at the Detective Bureau, I did advise him of his Rights, via a printed Rights Card, which I requested that he read out loud, which he did. He then refused to sign the card, saying he would rather not sign his name.

SGT. SAMOLOVITCH and I then transported KEITH WARREN to Mesquite, followed by ID SPECIALIST ADKINS.

KEITH was very specific as to the location of the various instances. He had little difficulty in locating any of the scenes.

1.8 miles east on that road, leads to a dirty road onto ABE TEERLINK's place.

After going through a cattle gate, we arrived approximately 100 to 200 yards off the roadway, by a yellow Catepillar tractor. KEITH advised that is where the original sexual assault occurred and that is where he forced the victim to disrobe, and cut the victim's hair.

SPECIALIST ADKINS photographed the scene, found light brown hair, which appeared to me to be similar in color to that of the victim.

Additionally, a quarter and 2 pennies in U. S. coin were found as well as a brown nylon wallet. KEITH said that was the wallet which he had just purchased and had apparently lost there, during the commission of the crime.

The second location, where KEITH removed the victim from the front seat and placed him in the back seat, was in the area of Riverside Bridge. He said it was on the north side of the Bridge. Nothing could be located at that scene.

He then directed us to the location where he cut the victim's throat. We were accompanied at that time, by OFFICER ROBISON who had been with us at the other two scenes, and DEPUTIES BAILEY and WELLS of the Mohave County Sheriff's Office.

This location was approximately 5 miles across the Arizona border, 1.25 miles north of the Sandy Wash Bridge. KEITH directed us to an area approximately 200 to 300 yards east of the roadway, adjacent to a swampy area. At that location, we discovered what appeared to be blood-like substances on the ground, and a red shoe lace, knotted in a circle, this being the probable scene where the victim's throat was cut.

We were joined at that scene, by SGT. JOHN THORNTON and OFFICER AL FISCH.

WARREN then directed us to the location that he had tied the victim to the post and sexually assaulted him, that being approximately one mile east of the Riverside Highway, on the Wind River access road. That scene was not processed at that time, because of failing light

We proceeded on past that point, to the location where the suspect said he burned the victim's clothes, that being approximately 5.9 miles east of the Riverside Highway on the Wind River access road.

The remains of the burned items were located and the scene was processed by SPECIALIST ADKINS and all identifiable materials were impounded as Evidence.

The suspect also said that he had tied the victim with a lasso and had thrown the lasso out in that area. We were unable to locate that, due to the darkness.

We then returned to the scene of the Sexual Assault by the fence post. SPECIALIST ADKINS photographed and processed that scene, also.

We then transported WARREN to the Mesquite Jail, where we secured him under the control of Officer WIMPLEY.

We then returned with a meal for him. We had previously provided him with lunch.

We then returned WARREN to the Clark County Jail. At that time, I advised him that I would be rebooking him, for the additional charges of 5 counts of Kidnap, With Use of Deadly Weapon, 7 counts of Sexual Assault, With Use of Deadly Weapon, Battery With Intent To Commit Sexual Assault, Battery With Deadly Weapon and Robbery With Deadly Weapon.

I then completed the re-booking.

Of note, OFFICER LOWTHER did provide me with a cassette tape containing a brief statement of SHANE HOOPES on 2-1-86. This statement will also be transcribed.

Investigation is continuing. Please refer to all reports under the above D.R. Number and subsequent Officer's Report, for complete details of the suspect's statement and up-dates on the investigation.

Officer Whimple then transported suspect to Clark County Jail where he was met by Detective Peter Beckman. Suspect told Det. Beckman that he wanted to go out in a blaze of glory, and said that he wanted to die. He also told Det. Beckman that he had intended to commit suicide at his first possible opportunity. He also told Det. Beckman that he had taken a life of a second human being.

At approximately 1145 hours, Sgt. Samolovitch and I went to the Clark County Detention Center and contacted Keith Warren. Keith was in an isolation cell, nude. He was covered by a blanket. He was placed in isolation after his clothing was impounded and after making threats that he would commit suicide. Pending an observation period, he was not given anything which he may injure himself with.

I identified and introduced myself to him. I then advised him, verbally, of his Rights per the Miranda Decision. He stated that he understood his Rights and waived his Rights. He said he did not wish to have an attorney present while he talked with us, and he had no objections to talking about the incident. He spoke very concisely, and told Sgt. Samolovitch and I that he had indeed kidnapped a child. He believed the child's name was he said he had asked the child his name. He had repeatedly sexually assaulted him, and taken him to a desert area on old highway 91 and cut his throat, then thought he was dead. He returned and was unable to find him. He returned several other times that morning, and still was unable to find the victim.

He seemed as if he wanted a great deal of attention. I advised him that he was in control of the situation and requested his assistance in locating the various crime scenes which he had taken the victim to in the Mesquite, Bunkerville, and Arizona strip area. He told me that he would accompany us, to help us do our "homework", as he put it. He alluded to the fact, at that time, that he had killed a second victim, but declined to give any further details.

Clothing was obtained for him, and a belly-band handcuff chain was placed around his waist and the handcuffs were secured to his wrist. He was then transported to the LVMPD Juvenile Bureau.

Upon arrival, I readvised him of his Miranda Rights, via a pre-printed Rights Card. I asked if he read, wrote, and understood the English language, and he said that he did. I then asked him to read this Rights card to me out loud, which he did. I asked if he had any questions about his Rights, and he said that he had been through this numerous times before, and knew exactly what his Rights were. I then advised him that he did not have to say anything to us unless he wanted to, and if he wished to have an attorney present before talking to us, one would be provided for him, free of charge, if he could not afford one. He said he knew that. I then asked him to sign the card acknowledging that he understood his Rights. He asked if he had to sign the card, I told him he did not. He said that he would rather not sign anything. I then dated and timed the card and signed my own name to it, and placed "refused to sign" in the signature block for him.

In the subsequent conversation, Keith Warren told us that he had been out driving the car, which he had recently purchased from Harley's Garage in town, being a white Ford, and as he was nearing his residence, being Adam's Place, he observed a young white male juvenile who he recognized. He pulled up adjacent to the subject and asked him if he wanted a ride, he said that got into the vehicle. They then drove out towards Abe the chil Teerlink's place and got out of the vehicle. At that point, Keith produced to take all of his clothes off. At the time that a knife, and tol he had full intentions of sexually assaulting him. and Keith picked up killing him. After forcing to disrobe, he said that he caused complied out of fear. Keith to give him a head job, slang for fellatio. hair off with the knife. said that after he did that, he cut some of shoes and his own shoes. He then drove down to the Western Village to pick up Eric. He told not to make any noise while he was in the trunk, or he would kill him. He then spoke with JoAnn and told her about his car having problems. Apparently, the vehicle was burning a great deal of oil, and this upset him immensely. He then talked to Eric. Eric had to work late, and Eric advised that he would get a ride home from Mike. JoAnn had already departed and Keith then drove away in his vehicle.

He then drove out to the Wind Rivers, or Wind Acres, area, east of Mesquite. He went out a dirt road and walked , who was still nude, into the desert and was going to tie him to a fence post and leave him there. He changed his mind and stru numerous times in the face and stomach. He then forced to perform fellatio on him. He then took back to the vehicle, and placed him in the vehicle and drove him back to his trailer at the Adam's place.

when he arrived he saw that JoAnn's car was still there, that being JoAnn Krukow. He to to not to make any noise and poked him in the back with the knife and forced him into his camper/trailer. He then forced to perform fellation him, and then 69'd with him, wherein he performed rellation with some vaseline lotion and rubbed his back, and then slid his finger into butt. He tried to put his penis in butt, but didn't make penetration. He didn't try that again. Sometime after 2:00 AM, he tool out to the back of the trailer, and took a shovel along with him. He began to dig a hole but hit hard ground, and was unable to dig any farther. He was going to bury there.

Keith returned to his vehicle and gave him a pair of baggie blue pants and a gray and tan shirt to put on. He then put him in his vehicle and drove out to the Arizona strip, that being old highway 91. He parked the car on the left side of the highway, and walked back across the road, and down into a ravine adjacent to a hill there. Once there, he offered the knife and asked him if he wanted to do it himself, referring to killing himself. He then

changed his mind and began to strangl He then began to cut neck. He said he wasn't sure how many times he cut his neck, but knew it was quite a few, and he only cut on and around his neck, he didn't cut anywhere else. He said he did not get any blood on himself. Prior to cutting and strangling he did remove the clothing that had been wearing. He said he thoug was dead. He then walked back up to his car, and decided to go back and check on When he did so, he could not find him and began to think that was possibly still alive. He went back to his car again, and returned a few minutes later. Again, he could not find

He attempted to start his vehicle, and it wouldn't start. He was able to get help from someone near a ranch he believed was called the Advocado Ranch, or something to that effect, and a man driving a white 4-wheel drive vehicle came out to help him. Apparently, Keith's battery was dead and the subject jumped the vehicle.

Resident Officers are attempting to locate and identify that subject now, so that a statement might be obtained.

After he got his vehicle jumped, he drove the road in an attempt to locate the victim, without success. He then returned to Mesquite and purchased some oil for his vehicle, as it was still burning oil. He then drove back out Highway 91 attempting to locate the victim. He noted that there were some beehives on the road, near where he had left him. He then receded out toward the wind Acre, or Wind River, area and burned all of J possessions and the clothes which he had allowed to wear.

He then went back to his residence at around 0800 hours. He saw JoAnn Krukow and her son, Thomas Adam, drive,by. He then went back to the trailer, and stayed there until approximately 1400 hours talking with Eric Brill, Rick, and other people.

He then left with Eric to go to the Lovelock LaPosada Restaurant to contact Gloria, who was the co-signer on his account. He could not withdraw money from the Credit Union in Virgin Valley without Gloria co-signing. They then went to the Credit Union, and he withdrew \$200 because he figured that he would have to be on the run. He already had approximately \$200 in his possession cashing his paycheck. After that, he spent time with Eric and Eric's girlfriend, Kirsten. They drove around, he purchased a case of Budweiser beer at the Stateline Casino. They took a friend of Eric's to work at the Western Village, then proceeded back towards the residence.

He saw the police vehicles there, and told Eric to keep on driving. He said that Eric asked him what was going on, and Keith told him that he had killed someone that night. Keith said that he said that because he didn't want to go on to a long explanation to Eric.

Ouring the course of this conversation, I asked Keith why he had done this. He said that he wanted to shake up Bunkerville and Mesquite because they had not treated him very well. He was very frustrated because they had refused him a raise at the Western Village and he was angry. He also said that he wanted to see the Resident Officer, Clark Robison, "get off his fat, lazy ass".

He showed absolutely no remorse or regret about what he had done

He told us that he had killed another person, he was very reluctant to talk about that initially. We were able to determine that he said that after being spotted by Officer Robison, at approximately 0300 hours, on 2-1-86, he had hid in the median of I-15. He said that this loud mouth, big shot cowboy was riding a horse down in the gully, and had a rifle and a handgun with him, and that when this cowboy saw him, he said, "There you are you scum". At which time, Keith said he jumped up and stabbed this cowboy and pulled him off his horse, put him in the bushes, then unsaddled the horse and let it go. He said that he had the gun the cowboy had for a short time, but decided he didn't use those kind of things and got rid of them. He only like to use a knife, he told us. He said that he left the body there, and that it should be easy to find if we would do our "homework". I told him that it would be bery difficult for us to find a body in that kind of terrain and requested assistance. He declined to give any more specific details at that time.

I asked if he had done similar things like this before, and he said that he had. I attempted to determine where, when, and how many other incidents he was taking responsibility for. He would not give any specifics.

During the search of his trailer, I did find a date book, which he had apparently been using for a Diary. In it were recepts from various locations, and notations that he had done quite a bit of traveling by hitchhiking, until he returned to Mesquite, several months ago, indicating that perhaps he had opportunity to commit other crimes in other localities.

Keith also told me that his father had began to sexually abuse him since he was approximately six years old, and continued until Keith was approximately 16 years old, when he decided that he had to runaway to escape this. Shortly thereafter, he was sexually assaulted on several occasions by persons on the road. Either people have pulled guns and knives on him and make him do sexual things. He also said that he was kidnapped by a bunch of bikers who took him into Montana, in the Blue Sky Country, as he put it, and repeatedly sexually assaulted him. He said that since that time, he has never been afraid of anybody because nothing worse could possibly happen to him. He said that he never told about what his father was doing because no one would ever believe him. He has told several adults in his life about what his father had done, and they said there was nothing that could be done to help him. He declined to say who these people he told were.

We then transported him from LVMPD to the McDonald's located on Las Vegas Boulevard and Lake Mead and purchased lunch for him. We ate lunch in the vehicle and followed by ID Specialist Atkins, who proceeded to the Mesquite area.

Upon arriving near the Riverside Bridge, on the Riverside Highway, we were met by Officer Robison. From there, Keith led us to the first location that he sexually assaulted the victim and cut his hair, that being on Abe Teerlink's Ranch. For specific location, please refer to previous officer's report. Once there, we found hair which was similar color to that of the victim's, 27 cents in coins, and a brown nylon wallet. Sgt. Samolovitch asked Keith about the wallet. Keith said that he had just bought the wallet a short time ago from Carter Store in Mesquite, and didn't know where he lost it, but that was definitely his wallet, he said. Sgt. Samolovitch asked him if it was a green wallet, and Keith told him, no, it was brown.

From that location, Keith showed us a general area where he stopped and put the victim in the trunk. There was nothing at that location to photograph or process.

We then proceeded to the location where Keith said that he cut the victim's throat. For that location, please refer to officer's report. Upon arriving, Keith directed us down a gulley on the east side of Old Highway 91, between two sets of beehives, and said he was down there in a small clearing adjacent to the marshy area. We located an area where there was wet ground. We felt that that was perhaps the location. We marked the area and continued to search. Keith said that he would be happy to come down and show us. He started down the hill where we found a blood-like substance adjacent to the first locale which we found. We also found a red shoe lace that was knotted in a loop, as well as blood-like substance and what was believed to be tissue or bone fragments Keith said that after he cut the victim's throat, he covered the victim up with broken branches, and that we should find broken branches there, which we did. It had apparently drizzled since the assault, and footprints in the area were somewhat distorted, so it was difficult to tell exactly what tread pattern of shoes had walked through. Keith indicated that the red laces were on a pair of boots which he was wearing at the time of the incident, and he had used them to tie the victim up, along with a lasso.

We then proceeded to the location where Keith tied the victim to a fence post. We marked that location, and as it was getting dark, we went to find the area where he burned the victim's clothing. We found that area. He said that it was near a small mound of dirt, and that he had covered over most of the debris but that some was still showing. When we arrived, we found some of the debris sticking out through a small mound of dirt, just as he had described. In addition we saw a tire track from a vehicle which had apparently made a U-turn there. He said that he had done just that, he had made a U-turn after burning the clothing the also said that as he was driving down the road, he threw a lasso out of the trunk, which he had forgotten to burn. Attempts to locate that were hampered by the darkness. He said he burned the victim's glasses, a calculator, his shoes and all the clothing. Fragments of these items were in fact located there.

We then returned and processed the scene where he had tied the victim to the post.

He told us that while the victim was in the trailer, he cried alot.

We spoke with him about the alleged homicide which he said he committed. He refused to give specific details, but did say that sooner or later we would find the body with his knife adjacent to it, and would know that he had done it. He said that he had purchased a set of knives from the Chief Chef of the Western Village Resort. He said the brand was Chef Master with black handles.

We returned Keith to the Mesquite Jail where Officer Whimple secured him. I thoroughly searched the cell prior to placing the suspect in, so that he would not have anything in which to injure himself with, if he still felt as if he wished to commit suicide. We unhandcuffed him, and removed the leg irons, and later returned with a meal for him. Earlier, he had told us that he wanted a steak for dinner from the Peppermill, being Western Village, and he said that he might show us where the body of the other victim was if we did that for him. I advised him at that time that if he wanted to cooperate, that was fine, but he would get his steak as requested no matter what he did for us that night. I advised him that we were not bribing him, or buying, his help, we were merely asking for his cooperation.

After he finished eating, we transported him back to Las Vegas
Enroute to Las Vegas, I asked him how he felt about doing those things to
He said he did not care, the child meant nothing to him. He said that after he knew the kid wasn't dead, he figured he had a 50-50 chance of surviving, and if God was with him, he would do it. He said, apparently God was with him. I asked him how he felt about the psychological trauma would feel, and he said it didn't make any difference anyway, he had people around to help him. He said why should he care about what he did to this kid because people have been doing that to him all his life. He honestly appeared to feel no remorse or regret for any acts he had done.

During the course of the day, I asked him if he would provide us with a written statement. He said he'd think about it. I advised him he'd probably have to write 15 or 20 pages to cover the incident fully. He said that was pretty long. I asked him about using a tape recorder to tape record his statement with him, he said he would never allow his voice to be tape recorded because a tape recorder had burned him one time. He went on to describe an incident where an attorney had tape recorded a sexual contact with him. He used that tape recording to black mail him with. Again, he refused to give specific details. He also said that he had lived with a man back East who had killed all those hitchhiking boys and buried them in the basement and his property. He said he didn't have any idea that this person was doing those things, and was glad that he wasn't one of his victims.

Keith kept saying that he wanted to go out in a blaze of glory and wanted to be executed. I explained to him, during our initial contact, that it would not be fair of him to try to escape or do anything else which would cause me to injure him, because I did not want to live with that on my conscience. He said that he did not want to go that way, he either wanted to be executed or take his own life.

He seemed fully aware of the seriousness of his acts and knew how wrong they were, but he still said that he wanted to shake up the community because of what they had done to him.

He was very concerned that one of his friends, named Eddy Olach, that being the person who identified himself as Jeffrey at the burned van scene, please see previous officer's report, was in trouble for harboring a fugitive, He said at no time did he have any contact with Eddy, either during the incident or after the incident prior to his apprehension. Eddy knew nothing about what was going on. He felt that Eddy was perhaps lying to protect him, and trying to throw us off track so that he would have more time to escape.

Eddy allowed officers to search his room at the Stateline Casino, room 3, for any property or items belonging to the suspect. None were found. There was no use in printing the room, as the suspect had been there on numerous previous occasions.

Upon returning the suspect to Las Vegas, I did advise him of the additional charges which he was being arrested for, and rebooked the suspect accordingly.

I additionally requested an extra set of FPC fingerprint cards to be completed so that I might forward them to the Federal Bureau of Investigations for comparison.

The suspect is currently wanted in New Hampshire for a weapons violation, however, on the NCIC incident, it does state they would only extradite in the eastern seaboard states. I will teletype them and advise them of the suspect's whoreabouts

Thoele, Utah, authorities will be advised, and attempts were made to contact Jay Lee Campbell in order to obtain a statement from him. Nevada Resident Deputies are also attempting to locate the cave where Keith was supposed to be hiding in, and will attempt to obtain a statement from the cook at the Western Village with whom Keith had an argument with preceeding the kidnapping. We will also the contact the personnel at Carter's market in an attempt to determine when the wallet was sold to Keith, and verify that he had purchased oil there after the attempted murder.

I contacted Deputy Bailey and advised him that the District Attorney's office in Las Vegas had said that due to the continuing nature of this crime, we would be able to seek prosecution of the attempt murder. He said that would be acceptable, and he would verify that fact with the Mojave County Attorney's Office, due to the fact that criminal incident originated in Nevada, and both of the crimes occurred in Nevada, with the Attempt murder occurring in Arizona.

Additionally, the bulk of the investigation had been conducted by LVMPD with Deputy Bailey's full assistance and cooperation.

In the course of the conversations, Keith also alleged that he had seen a person whom he lived with, that being Ray Hoppes, sexually abuse his children on numerous previous occasions. He said that the Welfare people had taken the kids out of the residence, and had returned several of the kids to Ray Hoppes, and he felt that he was still sexually abusing them. There were diary entries in Keith's date book when the children were taken into custody, and that he was trying to help Ray get the kids back.

I have since contacted Nevada State Welfare, and they had advised us that Keith Warren was in fact a character witness for the Hoppes during these proceedings.

The investigation is continuing. The ATLs and teletypes have been cancelled. The press release has been updated, and numerous media representatives have contacted the LVMPD Sexual Assault Office requesting additional information to this matter.

At this time, the victim is at Sunrise Hospital in room 305 East, where he is undergoing examination for possible neurological damage due to the hacking on the back of his neck. His condition is continually improving, and he was able to walk and take a shower today. I will attempt a further interview with him for more complete details tomorrow.

It should be noted that Keith was extremely frightened about having the media involved. He said that he did not want to talk to any media people without an attorney being with him. I assured him that we would not allow any representative of the media to contact him at this time.

Keith also said that he has been having sex with an 18 year old male in Mesquite Bunkerville area consentually, but refused to identify this person also.

They then returned this to me, and I subsequently resealed the package on 2-6-86, and impounded the negatives which it now contained.

With initial interviews with suspect KEITH WARREN, he indicated that he had firsthand knowledge of a subject named RAY HOOPES who resides in Mesquite, Nv. sexually abusing his children. Subsequently I contacted Nevada State Welfare and spoke with case worker MARK FITTGFRALD who advised me that he was aware of the case and that the subject labuse. He stated that sexual abuse was suspected but could never be confirmed. As such he requested that I reinterview the ildren in reference to this.

On 2/5/86 MARK FITZGERALD and I spoke with an They related numerous incidents of physical abuse but never any information on sexual abuse.

I also interviewed who spent a great deal of time with suspect WARREN is repeatedly mentioned in WARREN's date book and WARREN was apparently working with him on stopping him to wet the bed.

stated that WARREN would punish him by making him carry large buckets of water up and down hills but at no time was there ever any sexual contact.

On 2/6/86 DET. MC LAUGHLIN and I contacted KEITH WARREN at the Clark County Detention Center. I advised him of his rights per the Miranda Decision via a preprinted rights card which he declined to sign. However, he did state he understood his rights and did knowingly waive his rights. He stated that he did want to talk with us but he did not want to sign anything at that time I advised him previously that I had wished to take a taperecorded statement from him to detail all of the different occurrences which he had previously advised us about. He initially stated he would not do that; however, he contacted me and stated that he was willing to do that at this time.

WARREN told me that he would make the statement if I called his mother and allowed him to talk with her. His mother's name is CLAIRE DRIVAS. Her telephone number is (617) 475-2242. I advised him that whether or not he gave me a statement made no difference as I would contact his mother for him and allow him to speak with her if at all possible. I stated that makin a telephone call was not a condition of making a statement. If he wished to do so, he should tell me at that time. He told me he did wish to give me a statement. At that time we reviewed his rights per Miranda via the preprinted rights form on a statement. He signed the rights acknowledgement are waiver section.

I attempted to place a call to his mother for him without success. I advised him that I would return and attempt to contact his mother again on Saturday, 2/8/86.

DET. MICHAEL MC LAUGHLIN, P#541 witnessed the above. While I was attempting to make the telephone call to his mother, WARREN told DET. MC LAUGHLIN that his father made him have his hair cut short and have white sidewalls around his ears and that perhaps this was the reason why he cut the victim's hair.

DET. MC LANGHLIN departed. I then initiated a tape recorded statement with WARREN. I spoke with WARREN about his involvement wi what occurred during that incident and also about other crimes which he stated he had committed. He described to me two homicides which he committed in St. Louis, Missouri. He was fairly specific about certain details and very vague on others. However, the method of operation which he described was identical to that employed with

He also admitted to committing a homicide in or around Oliverona, Florida in the Florida Keys area where he cut his subject's throat. He said the subject's name was and then dropped s body into the ocean.

In my conversations with him I was able to determine that he preferred to victimize young white males with long, dark colored hair, primarily those persons living on the street so to speak. He said he liked them to, "talk tough." He said that he would initially befriend his potential victim and would provide them with beer or food or temporary shelter and in the course of that have voluntary sexual contact with them. At some point in his contact with them he would kidnap them by the use of a knife and force them to perform more sex acts with him and he would detain them for longperiods of time. At some point he would cut their hair with the knife. Then later he would kill them normally by cutting their throat. He said some he would cut the throat and stab them in the back and then dispose of the mude body and burn any possessions that the person might have had.

For complete details please refer to KEITH WARREN's transcribed statement.

On 2/8/86 I returned and visited KEITH ALAN WARREN at the Clark County Detention Center with his statement which had been transcribed. He reviewed the statement with me after I had readvised him of his rights. He said everything appeared pretty good and that's exactly what he did say, but did refuse to sign the statement.

Prior to initiating this interview I was able to contact his mother, CLAIRE DRIVAS and allowed him to speak with her. She then wanted to speak with me and advised me that she really didn't want to know what her son was doing or had done.
